






I also commend all the contractors who have partnered with the Governor in the realization of these infrastructural developments.

EDITORIAL


When the Governor Chief T. A. Orji mounted the rostrum of power on 29th May 2009, he promised to render services which will take Abia to the next level of development.

For the past two years, the Governor had religiously followed this promise, by embarking on various road projects in the state.




DUALIZED UMUAHIA OSSAH ROAD




AZIKIWE ROAD. UMUAHIA



YELLOW BUSES AND TAXI

- THE NEW FACE OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION IN ABIA STATE

When the present Administration of Chief T. A. Orji mounted the rostrum of power on the 29th of May 2009, it was faced with the challenges of improving the Transport Sector, as well as addressing the other sectoral needs of the State.

To tackle this problem, and change the face of public transportation in the state, the Governor embarked on a programme, towards providing sustainable Buses and Taxi transportation that will meet the needs of Abia State.

This programme paid-off on the 4th and 5th November 2008 when the Governor Chief T. A. Orji (Ochendo) launched the Abia Modern Buses and Taxi Scheme in Umuahia and Aba respectively, with a total of one hundred and twelve (112) brand new Buses and Cars, all painted yellow.

To further boost the new Transportation initiative and put it on a steady part of progress, the Administration of Chief T. A. Orji involved the private sector to partner with the State Government in meeting the transportation needs of the State.

Through this Public Private Participation (PPP), Carnation a giant in the Transportation Business, brought in forty (40) brand new cars for Taxi services in Umuahia, the capital City. The Governor flagged off the taxi scheme in Umuahia on 13th March 2009, and was code-named 'Hello Taxi'.

The taxis which are also painted Yellow have been operating in all parts of Umuahia and its environs, and will extend to Aba soon.

This new face of public transportation in Abia State have been carefully designed to serve as economic empowerment to Abians through providing employment to those who have learned the art of driving but lack the resources to purchase their own vehicles, as well as many school leavers who may wish to engage in the transportation business.

The Yellow Buses and Taxis including thee 'Hello Taxi' have not only changed the face of Abia, but have also added to the aesthetics of the cities where they operate.

It will also be a boost towards meeting the challenges of modern transportation, by ensuring comfort for passengers, as well as make inter and intra-city movements faster and safer.

As an economic empowerment, the Governor allowed beneficiaries of the first 112 Buses and Cars under the modern Buses and Taxi Scheme to repay the cost of the vehicles within 3 years through monthly instalment payments.

Equally, Carnation a partner in this new transportation initiative has also promised to transfer ownership of the Hello Taxis to their Operators (drivers) after three years successful operation.

To ensure the success of this new Transportation Scheme, the Administration of Governor T. A. Orji has within two years in office embarked on massive construction, reconstruction, and rehabilitation of roads in all parts of the state, including Federal roads.

This effort of the Governor will ensure good motor able roads in the state, and facilitate the evaluation of agricultural products from the hinterlands to the city centres.


The new public transportation initiative has offered an alternative to the commercial motorcycle popularly called 'Okada' which has been a major transportation system in the state. People can now choose the comfort of air-conditioned yellow buses and taxis for inter and intracity travels, or the accident prone 'okada'.

This project embarked upon by the Administration of Chief T. A. Orji (Ochendo) in Abia State, has left no one in doubt that his mission in governance is to bring prosperity to the people.

THE ABIA ROAD MARSHALL

When he was sworn – in, on 29th May 2007 as the Executive Governor of Abia State, very few people believe CHIEF T. A. ORJI could deliver in Governance. But the Governor confounded his most ardent critics with his style of Governance which social commentators have come to call OCHENDOMANIA – a type of Political economic engineering which combines fluid bureaucracy and the swiftness of the private Sector in turning the state around on the path of development and progress.

By this his peculiar system, the Governor CHIEF (DR) T. A. ORJI has been Able to affect

the facet of the state's economy, including roads and the transport Sector.

It is the Road and Transport Sector which is under the Ministry of Works and Transport that the barometer of the achievements of the Governor will be measured. The Governor on being sworn in on the 29th of may 2007 in a very spectacular and miraculous way identified early in his Governance, that for him to affect the Governed, that he must create access to the communities in the three Senatorial Zones of the State.

Thus he initiated the "One road to every local Government Council "policy" of his administration, without losing focus of the urban centres of Umuahia, Aba, Abiriba, Arochukwu, Igbere, BEnde, Ukwa, Ohafia etc.

Within two years in office, our dynamic and amiable Governor has awarded over 100 road projects, cutting across the three senatorial Zones of Abia South, Abia Central and Abia North.

Many of these roads have been completed and commissioned, many are nearing completion and a few at various stages of completion.

The underlisted road projects have been completed and would be commissioned on the 29th May 2009 to commemorate the Governor's two years in office.

One thing with the Executive Governor and the Ochendomania phenomenon is that the Governor does not only depend on reports by his lieutenants. He personally visits and inspects the development projects himself. Having come from the Civil Service, (his Constituency) the Governor as a seasoned technocrat knows that sometimes some of these reports are misleading, that also informed his directive that only Contractors who have earned job certificates on projects would receive his approval for payment – an apostle of probity and accountability.

The Governor having also recognized that the Civil Service in Abia is a Partner in Progress, for the first time provided asphalted link roads between the five major housing estates in Abia namely: World Bank, Low Cost Housing, Isieke, Agbama and Ehimiri Housing estates to the Nnamdi Azikiwe secretariat and Government offices (Federal and State) in the new Government Layout.

For visitors, when you are in Abia and you hear of the ROAD MARSHALL, Abians are not talking of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), they really mean CHIEF (DR) T. A. ORJI – a man who has bestrode the Abia development terrain like a human Collossus he is: ORJI – the towering Iroko tree. When next you see him, remove your cap, and say "BRAVO, your Excellency" on your two years in office.




