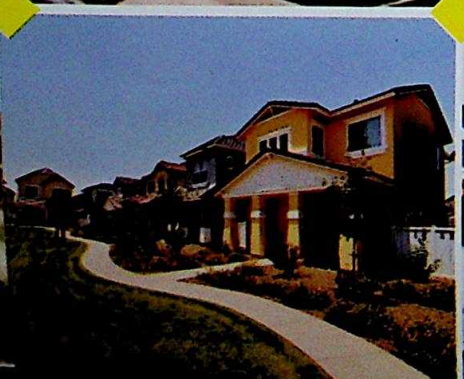


## OPEN YOUR MIND TO THE KADUNA MILLENNIUM CITY

# Brief on Kaduna



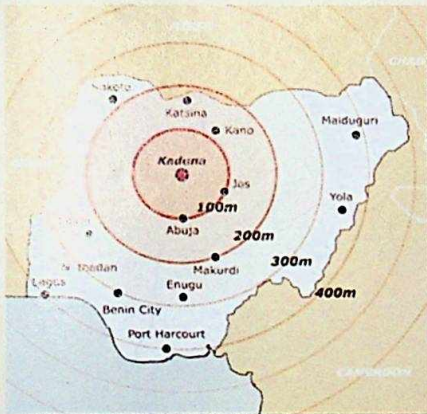
**K**aduna State, founded by the British in 1913, is known as Centre of Learning due to its highly skilled labour force and largely due to the presence of large number of institutions of higher learning like the Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria, the State University, Kaduna Polytechnic, Nuhu Bamali Polytechnic, Zaria, Institute of Transport Technology, College of Civil Aviation, Zaria, and many ICT Training Institutes. Kaduna city was the capital of the defunct Northern Region from 1917 to 1967 and remains an important political centre in Northern Nigeria. It has two airports, a railway station, an oil refinery and petrochemical plant. A variety of recreational facilities are also located in Kaduna. These include two stadia, two amusement parks, a sporting complex with modern facilities (Murtala Mohammed Square), a museum, 2 Polo clubs, a Golf club, Rugby club, and a race course, etc

## **Market, location and existing service conditions.**

Kaduna State is centrally located in northern Nigeria and occupies an area of 50,000 square kilometers.

Kaduna State's main cities are Kaduna, Zaria and Kafanchan. The capital, Kaduna, is located on the Kaduna River and serves as a trade center and transportation hub for neighbouring states (rail and road junctions converge in Kaduna city and Kafanchan). Kaduna State is a 30-minute flight or 2-hour drive from Abuja (capital city of Nigeria) and a 1-hour flight from Lagos (Nigeria's commercial capital). The State's central location, many transportation options, and proximity to Kano, the ancient city, Abuja and Lagos give it a locational advantage, allowing local and foreign Investors to access larger markets

Kaduna has a population of 6,066,562 (2006 census) and about 80 percent of the State's population is engaged in agriculture, producing both food and cash crops. Traditional methods are being replaced with more modern farming inputs and techniques.



The state's economy has boomed in recent years due to growth and development initiatives of Gov Arc Mohammed Namadi Sambo, improved investment climate, implementation of democratic reforms and its role as a northern agriculture growth pole. Agriculture remains the mainstay for the economy and largest employer (agriculture accounts for 56 percent of Gross State Production). Cash and food crops are cultivated in commercial and family farms. The State has also seen a steady increase in light manufacturing with new investments in the formal sector.

Kaduna State has recently adopted policies to take into account the interests of local, national and foreign investors. Reforms in the Health Sector, in Education with ICT as a key strategic implement, Poverty Alleviation and so many social programs. To promote industrial and commercial enterprises, Kaduna State Government under the leadership of Arc Mohammed Namadi Sambo is providing several enabling environment for new socio-economic status and infrastructural development including the creation of a new city called: Kaduna Millennium City.

Kaduna is the only state in Nigeria with a functioning rail system and is reputed for having one of the best road systems in Nigeria, with 2,820 kilometers of trunk roads radiating from Kaduna City in five directions and an additional 1,200 kilometers of tarred roads. The railways converge at Kaduna city from Lagos in the southwest and Port-Harcourt in the southeast; and extend to Zaria where railway lines branch off Zamfara and Kano State. The Intra and Inter - City Mass Transit Train Service, coupled with the well-developed road and railway system provides cheap transportation of products, raw materials and people.

Kaduna State has been rated the best in the country in the area of security and peace since the introduction "OPERATION YAKI", a specialized security outfit well equipped with the latest communication gadgets and support personnel. World Bank economic indicators that attract and enhance business activities (doing business safely 2008 ranked Kaduna: among the safest in Nigeria, the easiest place to do Business in Nigeria, second best to Abuja in business start-ups and the cheapest place to build warehouse or factory in Nigeria. Kaduna State is indeed the meeting place in northern Nigeria.

For two months, His Excellency Arc. Mohammed Namadi Sambo, FNIA, the Executive Governor of Kaduna State traversed the nooks and crannies of the 23 LGAs in Kaduna State to inspect, flag-off and commission the very many projects his administration embarked upon since its inception pursuant to the Governor's promises to deliver on his 11-point Agenda, which complements Mr. President's 7 Point Agenda. The TOUR, though tortuous yet smooth, was not without its toll as the Governor went to hinterlands and met with people who demonstrated and showed their display of love and affection by the manner in which the Governor was received by them. A midst pomp and pageantry, there was the warmth of friendship, companionship, brotherliness and above all togetherness that binds everyone together.

From the Local Government Area, where the journey commenced, to Soba Local Government Area, which became the last bus stop, there were joys, support and prayers to the architect of human and physical development, Gov. The highlight of the tour, though centered round the delivery of dividends of democracy to the citizens in terms of projects, other side attractions aimed at Poverty Alleviation and reduction were successfully embarked upon. In each local government council visited, farmer cooperative societies were advanced loans of four hundred thousand Naira (N400,000) for each society amounting to a total sum of N4million naira per Local Government which sums up to N92million across the State as a deliberate intervention to support our small scale farmers.

Medium and large-scale farmers were not left out as they were also patronized with a total sum of N200million, which was disbursed as soft loans to enable our farmers partake fully in this farming season.

Similarly in, Birnin Gwari Local Government Area, the sales of fertilizer for year 2009 farming season was launched and each bag of assorted fertilizer was sold at half its cost price. This subsidy amounted to the sum of N2.5 billion.

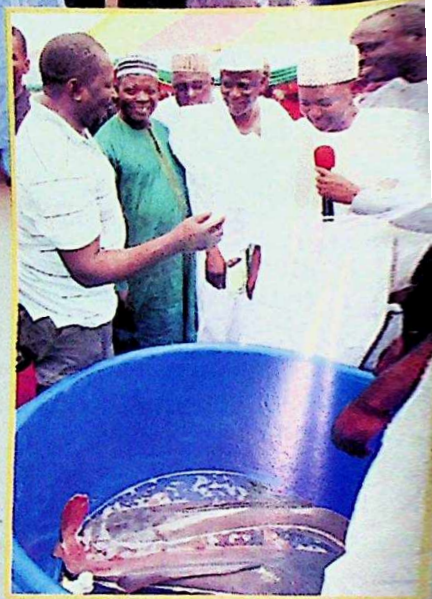

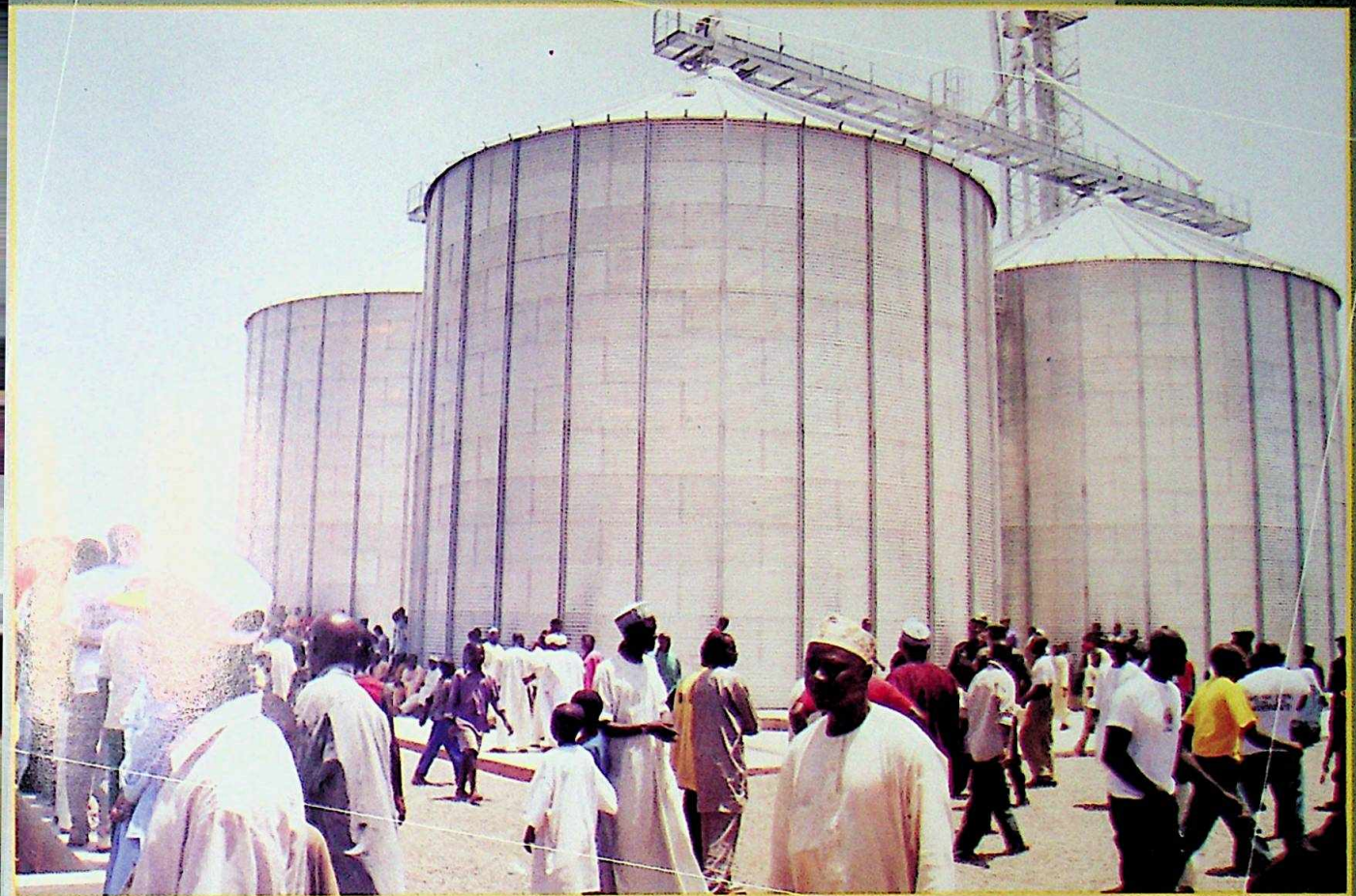




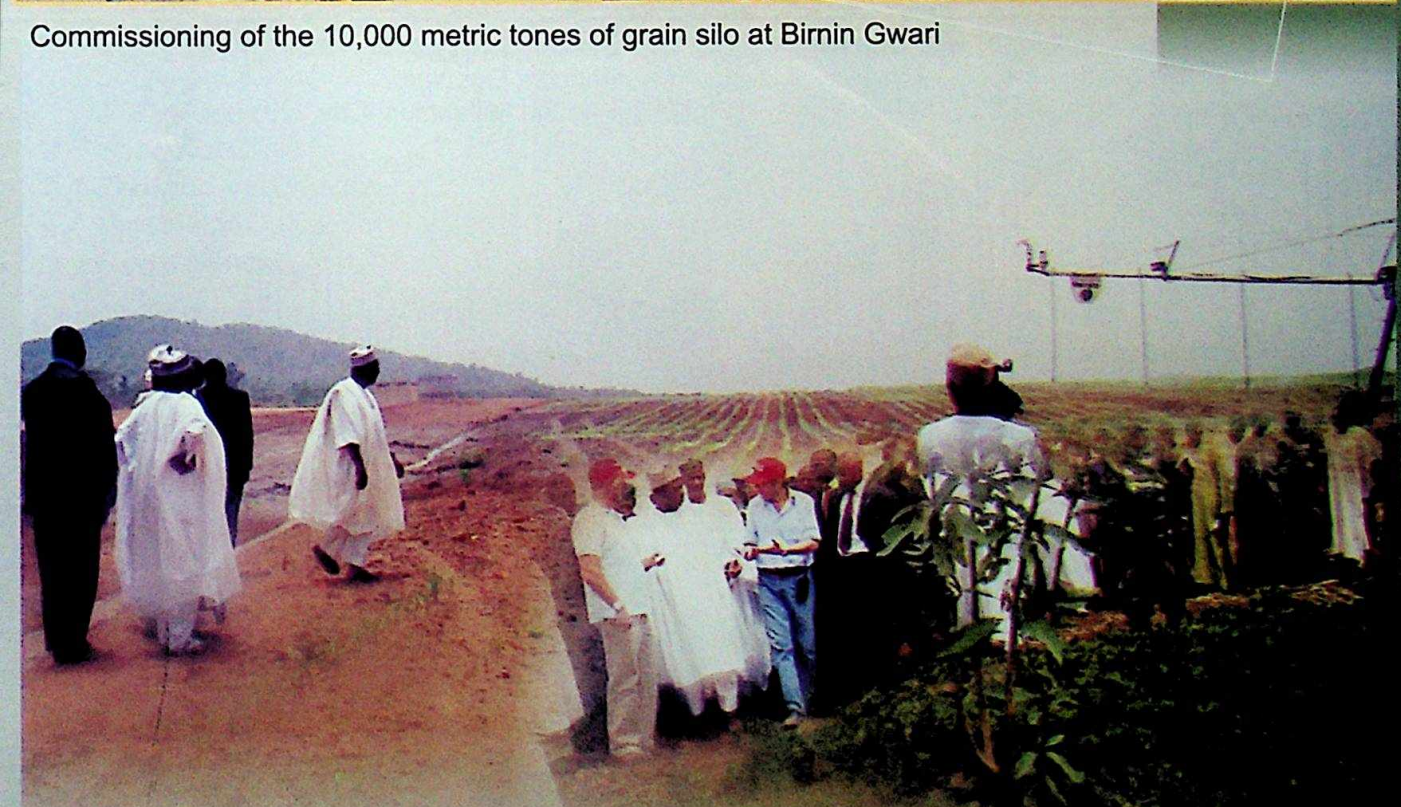

Commissioning of the 10,000 metric tones of grain silo at Birnin Gwari

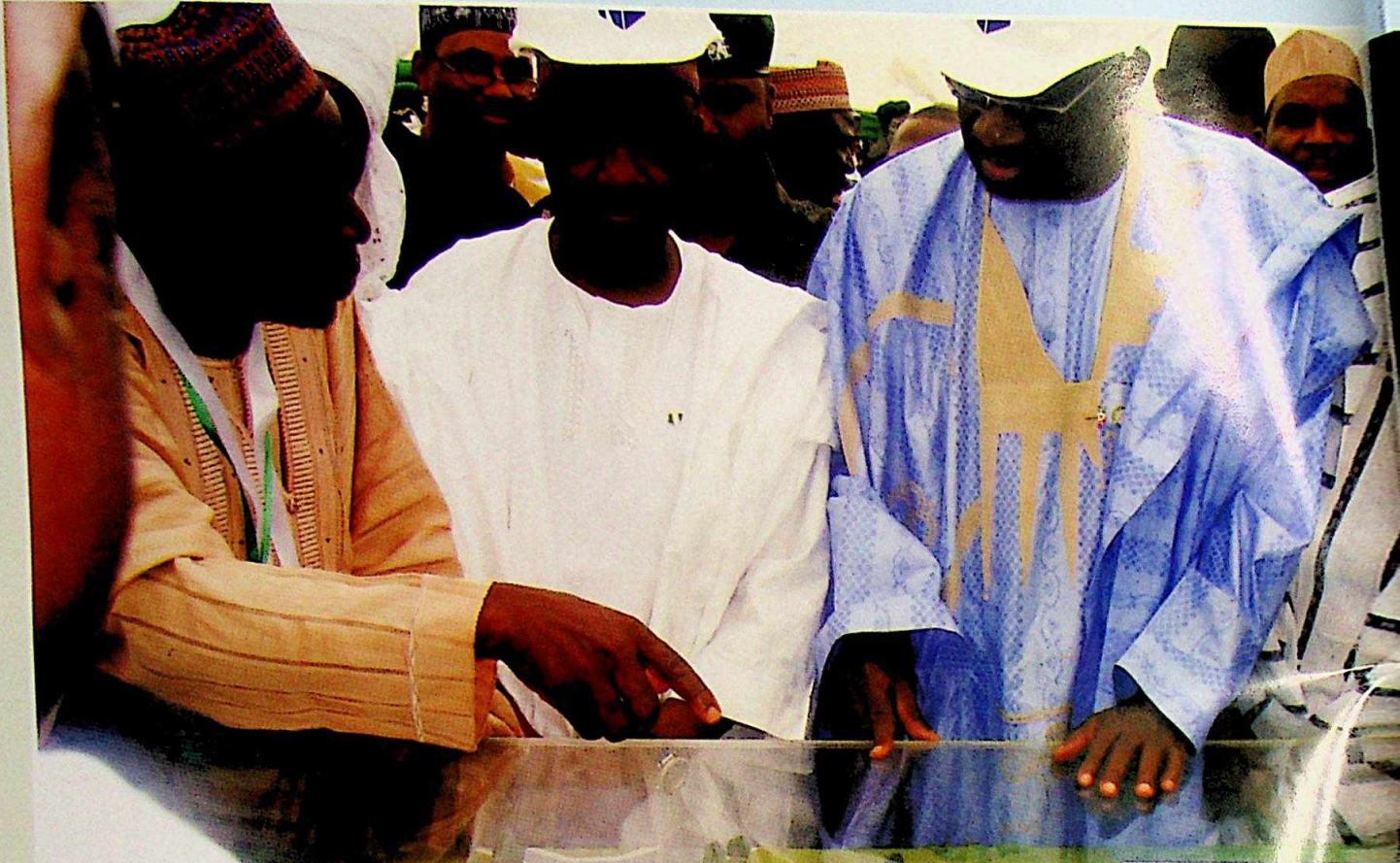

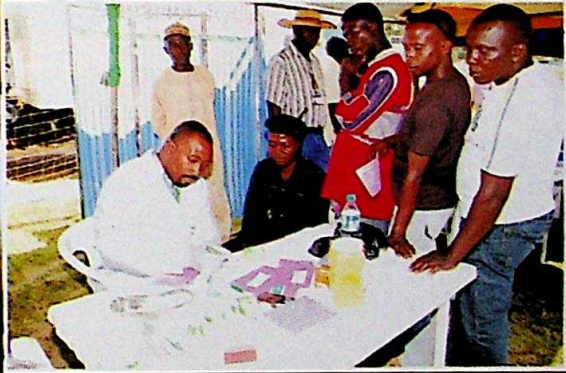

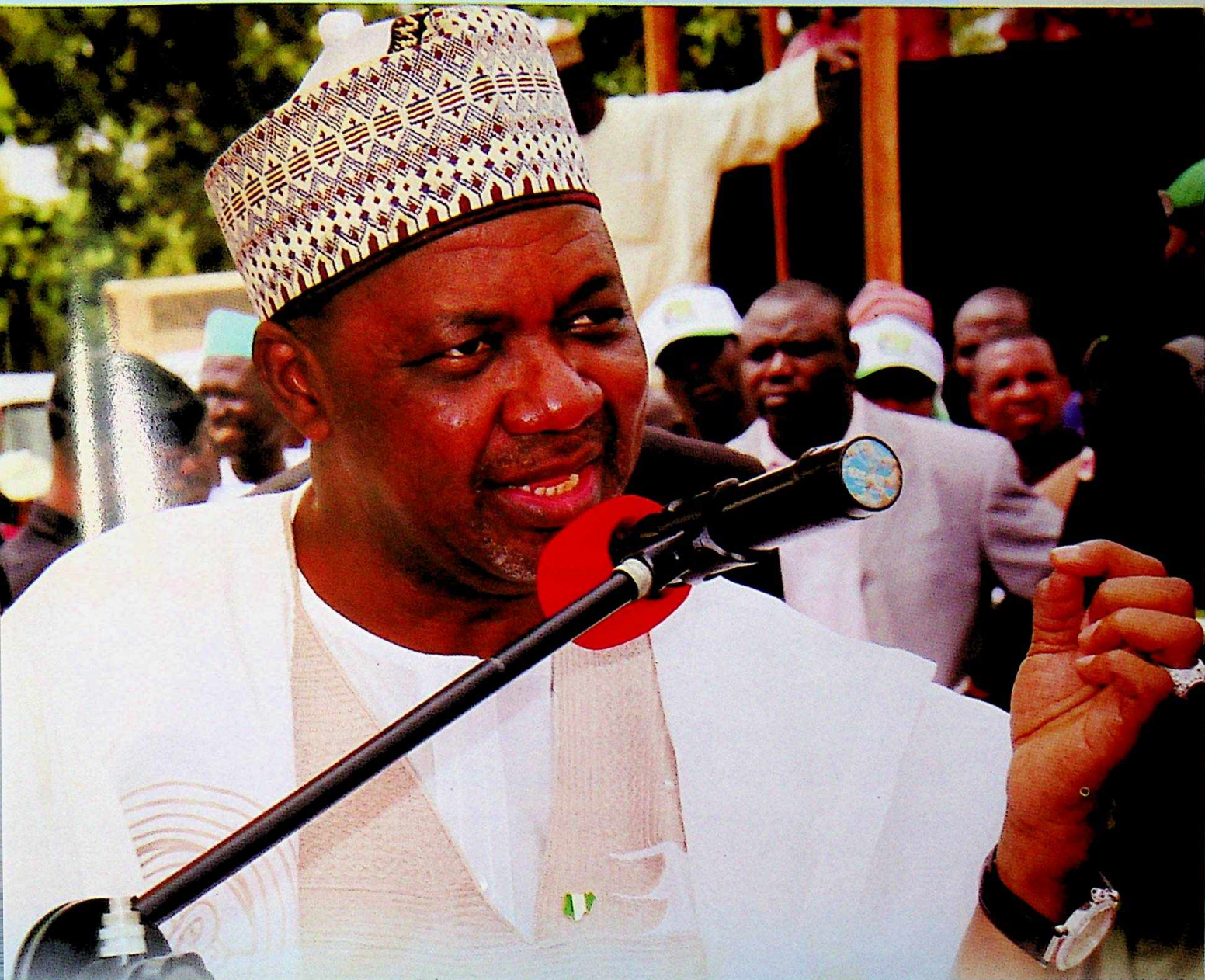

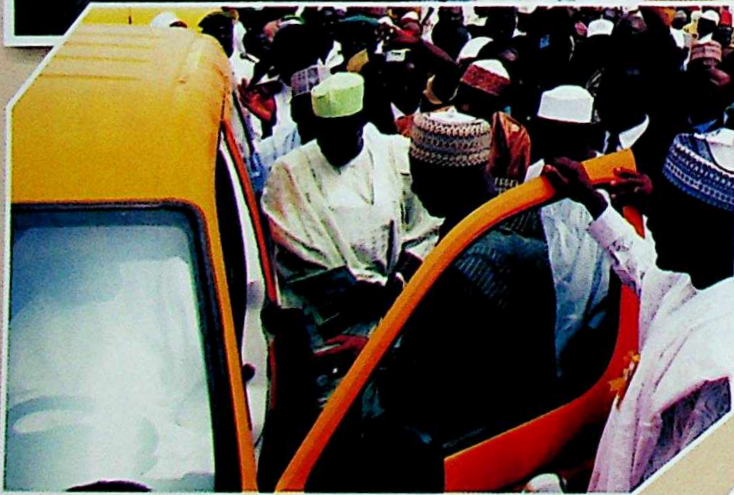

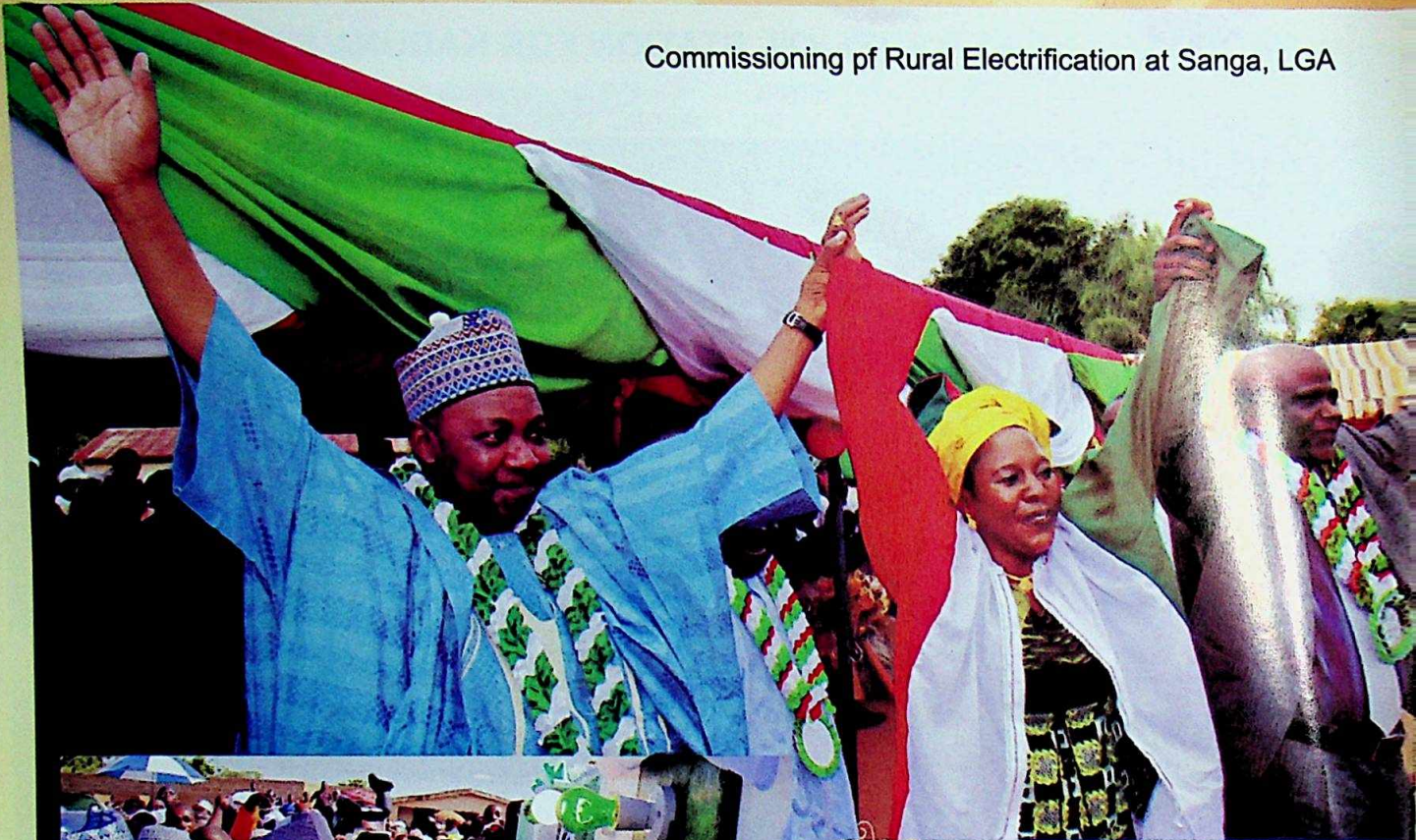

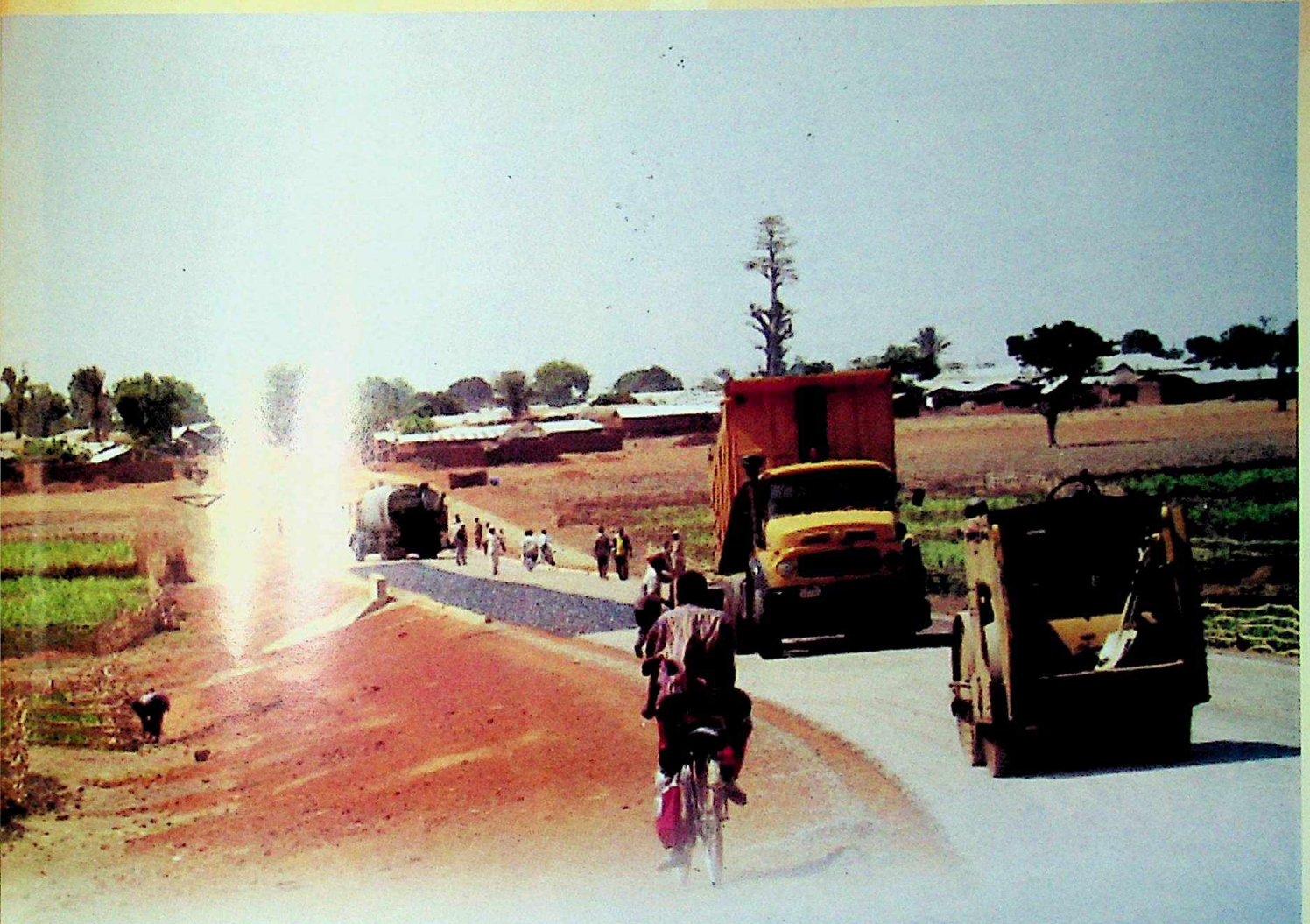

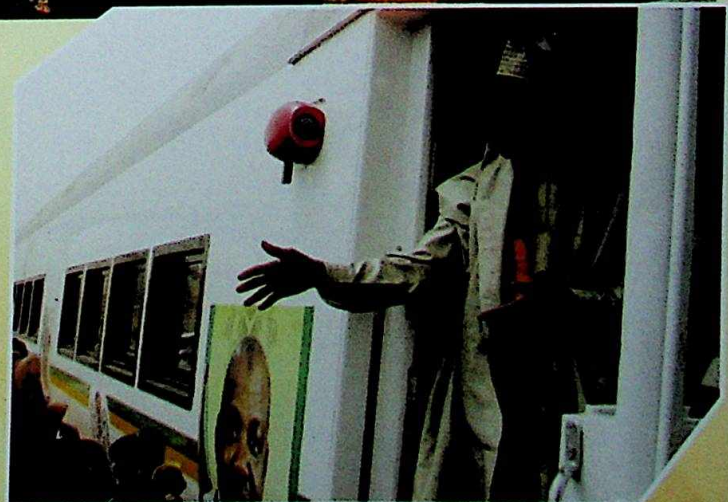

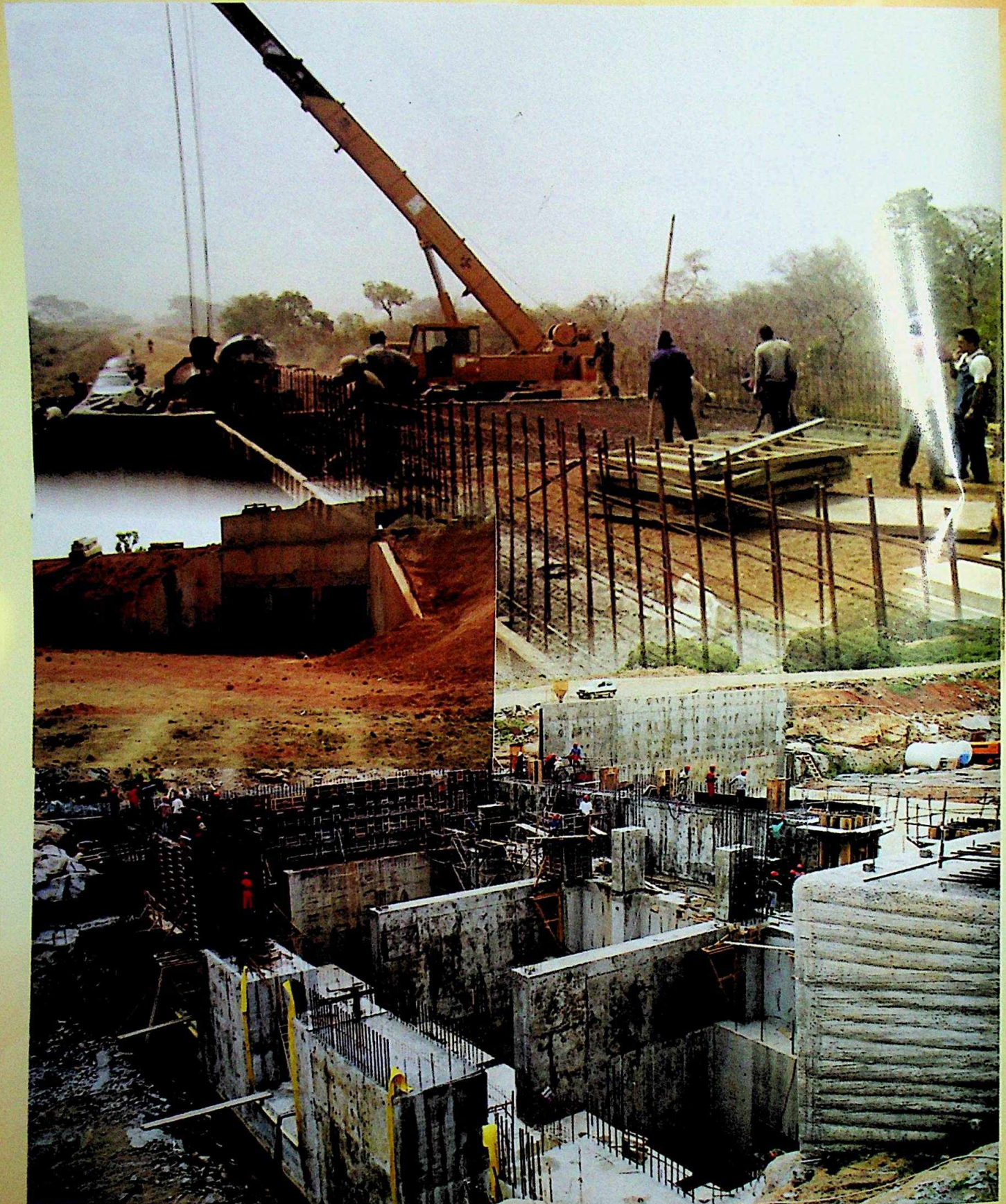


The Proposed Speed rail from Kaduna Millennium City to Abuja in 1.5hrs

# Mass Housing

Work will soon commence in the Kaduna Millennium City on the N4.2 billion Phase I - 1000 housing units project to be financed by Mortgage loan from the Federal Mortgage Bank of Nigeria (FMBN) also under PPP.



Phase I - 1000 housing units: Designs of 2 bedrooms detached, semi-detached; 3 bedrooms detached/semi detached; 4 bedrooms bungalow and blocks of 3 bedrooms storey building all to be sited at the Kaduna Millennium City and to cost about N4.2 billion and to be financed by Mortgage loan from the Federal Mortgage Bank of Nigeria (FMBN)

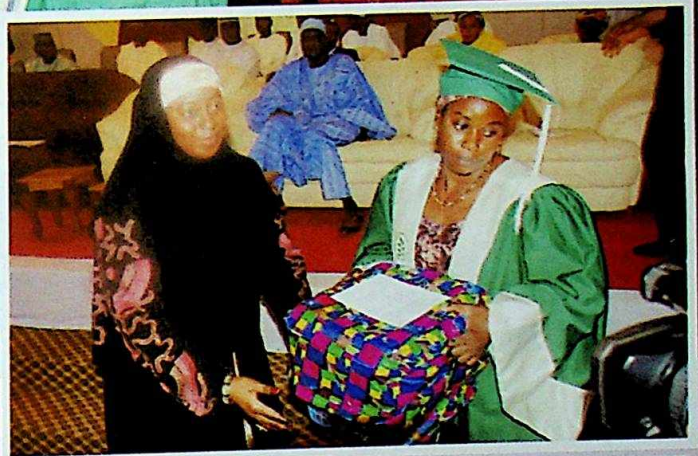

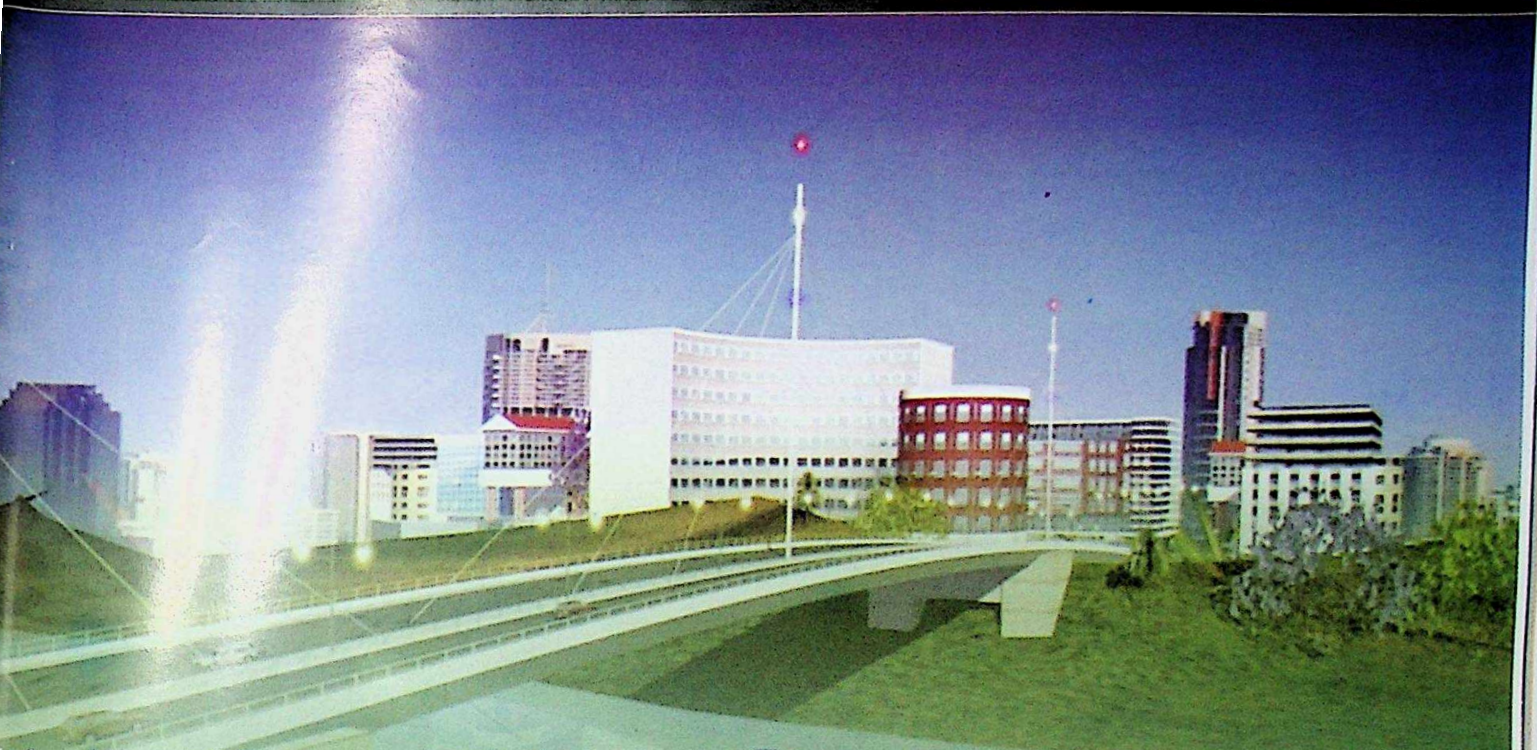




# Millennium City

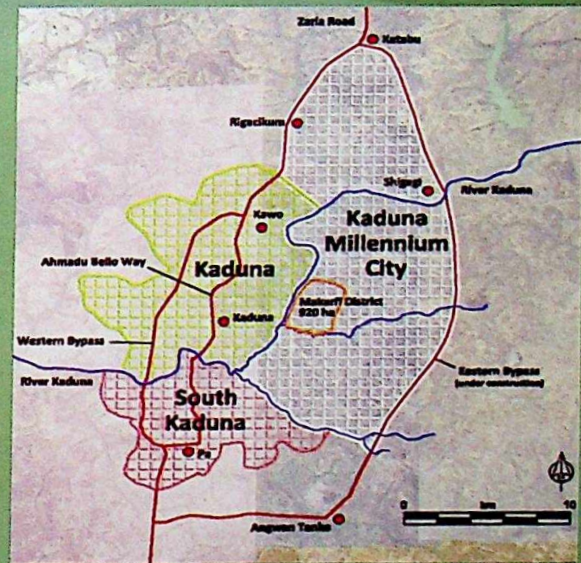






Kaduna Millennium City is a new urban development project. The city will sit within the rolling slopes of the eastern bank of the river Kaduna. The natural streams and valleys found in this lush landscape serve as the idyllic backdrop of the city's future residents and visitors, helping to create a grade-style retreat with luxury and recreational facilities and a quality lifestyle. There will be 10 districts in the Millennium City and the first district will have the following feature:-

- 20 hectares of prime developable space
- 10,000 residents
- 5,000 jobs
- 8,000 homes
- 8 development parcels
- 200 residential building plots
- 50 non-residential building plots
- 70 parks and pocket parks
- x 50 bed hotels
- x 200 bed hospital
- x ICT Park



Speed train from Kaduna Millennium City to Abuja





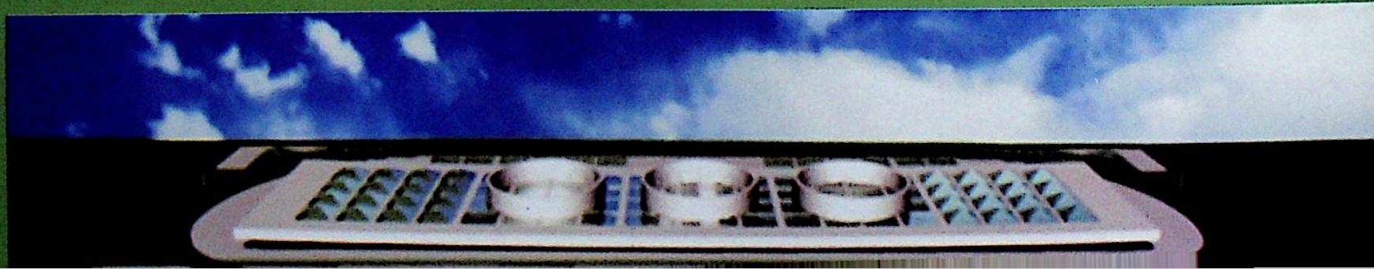
# Shopping Complex

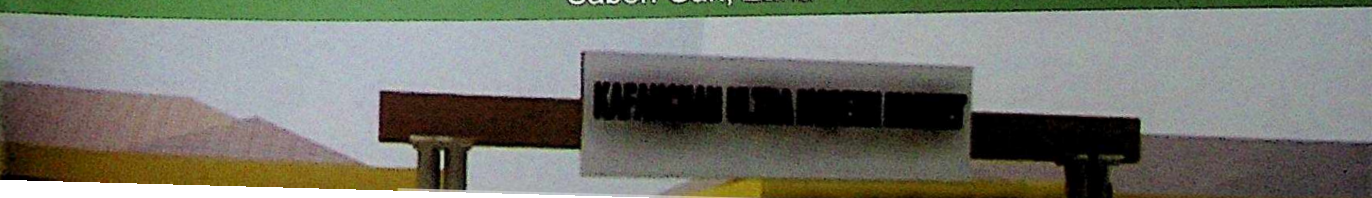

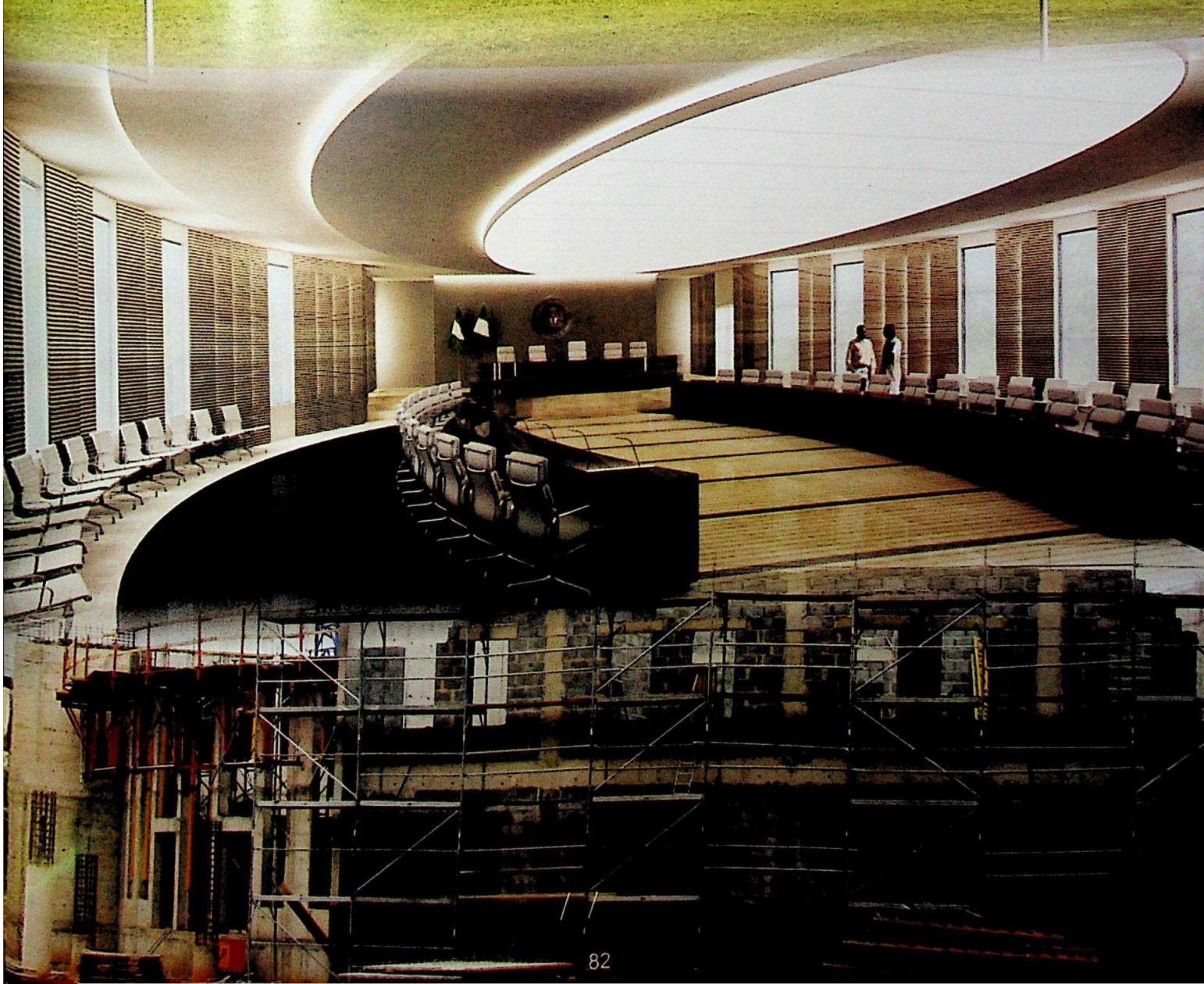

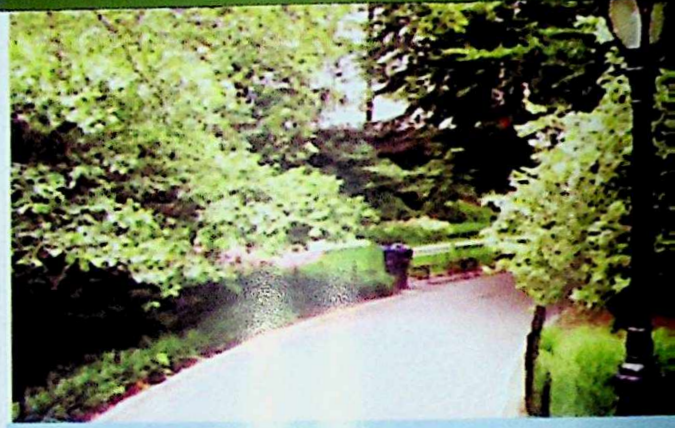






# Culture

- vii. Staff village Local economic, community and cultural development

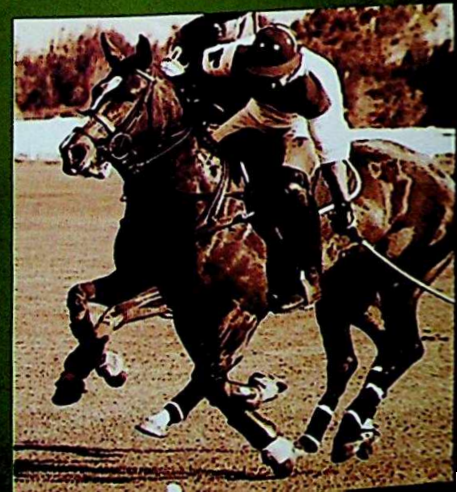
