

OGUN STATE PROFILE

State Capital:

Abeokuta, which is about 80km North of Lagos, Nigeria Commercial Capital City.

Location:

Ogus State on South — western Nigeria. It is bounded to the West by Benin Republic to the South by Lagos State and to the North by Oyo and Osun States.

The People:

The people of Ogun State belong to the Yoruba ethnic group of South-West of Nigeria.

Languages:

Yoruba and English (official language), and several dialects of the sub-groups.

Vegetation:

High forest zone of rain forest in the southern part and predominantly savannah region in the north.

Climate:

Tropical pattern with rainy season starting about March and ending in November and followed by dry season. The mean annual rainfall varies from 128cm in the southern parts of the State to 105cm in the northern areas.

Natural Resources:

Endowed with extensive fertile soil for Agriculture; with savannah belt in the north-western part suitable for



cattle rearing. Vast forest reserves, rivers, a lagoon, rocks, mineral deposits and an oceanfront.

Agemo, Lisabi, Ogun, Igunuko, Orisa-Oko, Egungun, Obirin –Ojowu, Gelede, Oro, Ojude-Oba and Sango.
