all outstanding amounts to the States. However, at the last meeting a dispute arose again but NNPC's previous acceptance of liability was established from the minutes of previous meetings. Upon meeting the Minister, it appeared there was no knowledge of the agreement, and in fact the issue of payment of outstanding amounts had not been tabled before the President. The Forum of Finance Commissioners therefore took a stand not to attend future meeting if agreements were not honoured.

iv. He also noted that although CBN admitted to holding outstanding balances \$5m, CBN had stated that it was not at liberty to make any payments without the mandate to do so.

v. He noted that under his stewardship his Forum had uncovered discrepancies amounting to about N2.09tr

vi. The Commissioner also expressed concern that the Minister of States' decision to merge the FAAC meetings with FAAC Post Mortem, which was the platform for scrutiny that the commissioners had, would significantly weaken the Forum of Commissioners and their ability to pursue these matters effectively.

d) In response, a member noted that although there is a constitutional provision for separate meetings, late submissions of returns in particular by NNPC has often impacted on the timing of meetings and very often necessitates merging of meetings. This needed to be addressed so as to limit the need for joint meetings in future.

e) The Forum resolved to provide political support to their commissioners and the Forum of Finance Commissioners to enable them complete the task.

f) It was also noted that the management of the ederation account had become an issue. The rapid decline in the national reserve is alarming and as a result the NASS had decided to send the budget back to the Presidency without treatment.
