1	COMMENCEMENT  The meeting started at 5.25pm with opening prayer by Nosa Orumwense (Zenith Bank). Owing to the unavoidable absence of the Director General (DG), the meeting was presided by the Executive Director (ED, Strategy & Research). There were general introductions of everyone present.	
	<ul> <li>The Project consultant summarized the raison d étre of the meeting as follows:</li> <li>The essence of the meeting was to kick start the physical development of the NGF secretariat.</li> <li>He traced the history of the relationship between the forum and the consultants and the various stages of presentations made to the forum in respect of the preliminary aspect of the project.</li> <li>The meeting was partly to hand-over the site to the contractor and partly to discuss the issue of payment of 25% of the total project cost to them.</li> <li>They presented 7 copies of the contract Agreement (1 Original and 6 certified true copies) as well as 2 sets of drawings.</li> <li>They prayed that pursuant to the approval given by the Forum at its last meeting on 26/01/09, a letter should be given to the consultants to this effect</li> <li>They presented a certificate approving payment of the said 25% of total project cost to the contractor.</li> <li>They informed the meeting that an Advance Payment Guarantee (APG) had been presented by the contractor but there were certain observations made by the project consultant which necessitated the withdrawal of the APG.</li> <li>They gave assurances that as soon as the new APG was ready, same would be presented to the forum.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>A representative of AFRIBANK reiterated their earlier request for a formal letter of request to part-finance the project.</li> <li>The issue of registration as a condition-precedent to consummating the relationship was discussed.</li> <li>Wondered if there was a precise time for draw-down of the money.</li> <li>The EDs gave assurance on the issue of registration and also promised that s soon as this was done, the formal letter would be written to them.</li> </ul>	

- The EDs also acknowledged that time was of the essence and assured the bank that the forum was already on course to raise its own part to the total cost.
- On the question of the banks' readiness to part-finance the project and whether they intended to go it alone or as a syndicate, their common response was that they would prefer a syndicate finance arrangement.
- Regarding a firm commitment on participation, they also stated that the level of representation at the meeting made it difficult for them to make any binding commitment. They would report back to their superior on the outcome of the meeting and then get back to the forum.

### FORMAL HAND-OVER OF SITE.

It was agreed that a formal hand-over could not go on in view of DG's absence. The meeting was assured that any decision as to when this would take place would be communicated to them in due course.

#### **CONTRACTOR'S REMARKS**

The contractor expressed its readiness to move to site upon completion of necessary formalities.

#### CONCLUSION

The meeting ended at about 6.15pm with closing prayers by Munir Nimat.
