





The Process



State visits the IGR Dashboard via the www.nggovernorsforum.org/igrdashboard url



Step 2

State completes monthly data sheet and quarterly questionnaire as required



Step 3

Dashboard Manager reviews submissions from States and uploads data online



Step 4

State reports are developed and presented to Governors monthly and the Joint Tax Board quarterly (including key highlights, recommendations and data analysis)



Data Collection and Analysis

Data is collected by using an objective-based questionnaire to be completed at quarterly intervals by SBIRS. (Statistics on a monthly basis)

This collects information under each of the following headings:


- Tax Administration
- Tax Procedure
- Tax Processing
- Tax Enforcement

It provides a diagnostic study of the State's IGR infrastructure and identifies specific areas that require interventions.

Key elements - research, evidence and peer learning.

State Monthly Reports

The NGF Secretariat will provide on a monthly basis – commencing April 2017 a report for Governors and State Boards of Internal Revenue that highlights:

- The status of States' Boards of Internal Revenue;
- An update of the IGR status in relation to key enablers;
- Recommended actions to address challenges to increased IGR;

- Commendable practices for peer learning




