EKITI STATE OF NIGERIA

Commencement

(January, 2023)

Enacted by the Ekiti State House of Assembly as follows:

***Appropriation.* 1. i**

The **Accountant General of Ekiti State** may, when authorized to do so by warrant signed by the **Commissioner for Finance** pay out of the **Consolidated Revenue Fund of Ekiti** during the financial ending 31st December, 2023 the sum specified warrant not exceeding in aggregate the 2023 Estimate of **One Hundred and Thirteen Billion, Five Hundred and Seventy-Two Million, Seven Hundred and Eighteen Thousand, Five Hundred and Twenty-Three Naira, Eighty-Two Kobo. (₦113,572,718, 523.82)**

Schedules I & II.

- ii** The amount mentioned in **Sub-section (I)** of this Section shall be appropriated to Head of **Expenditure** specified in **Schedules I & II** to this Law.
- iii** No part of the amount afore-said shall be issued from the **Consolidated Revenue fund of Ekiti State** after the end of the year mentioned in sub-Section (i) of this **Section**.

This Law may be cited as the 2023 Appropriation Law.


