- 2. Strengthen the process of peer based learning and sharing of developmental experiences and increase its potential to improve good governance and socio economic development at the state level
- 3. Enhance the visibility of the NGF and its capabilities with its stakeholders including Federal bodies, International Development Partners (IDPs), NGOs, and the media through an effective communication strategy, designed and implemented.
- 4. To develop a lean and effective management and operational Secretariat that delivers the long-term goals of the Forum.
- 5. Strengthen the secretariat as the efficient and effective engine of the Forum that acts as an effective policy hub of the forum delivering context specific and relevant policy advice and providing all round

capacity strengthening services to Governors in their day to day running of their States

Adam,

Thanks for taking the time to follow up with Bukar. Like you I appreciated him for pulling this off despite his busy schedule. I agree with you that it will be useful for him to complete the KM activities for the other objectives. I am yet to receive a response from the DG on the changes they have made to the Strategic Objectives but I see some value in threading some of the Outputs of the KM of any objectives that have been dropped. The mere fact that an objective was retained after that participatory process used at the workshop to determine priority objectives suggests that the issues implicit in each objective are important even if they do not qualify as strategic.

Overall, I think the input is a good start. As Objectives/Results/Activities/Budgets get defined it will be necessary for the KM strategy to be more specific in terms of the knowledge that is likely to be generated and disseminated as part of the functions of the Secretariat. It may then make it easier to sell it to Governors and hopefully build upon the knowledge to be generated to develop a financing plan which the principals can buy into. The secretariat needs to generate significant untied revenue to become effective and relevant to Governors and the development process in States.

I am pleased you are working with the SPARC KM team to further develop the KM framework and strategy. The M&E person on the team is doing further work and should be presenting his first draft input by close of day today. He expected to generate information on the following:

- Indicators
- Means of verification (data source, data collection method, frequency of data collection, responsibility for data collection)
- Indicative targets and time-frames (lifted from the circulated goal statement, strategic objectives, etc).
- Assumptions and risks relating to meeting the indicative targets and time-frames

- * Use of the M&E information (Reporting and Presentation) that will be generated.
- A column for the insertion of the cost of data collection

My understanding is that his input will further assist you flesh out NGF's KM and Communication strategy. Otherwise, the zero draft is designed to be complete in the sense that it will contain elements covering all aspects of the NGF Strategic Plan outline which is attached. Realistically, I do not expect all elements to be finalized so it is better to have as much as you can flesh out now to enable me pull all the elements together into a coherent whole. As it goes through the first, second and possibly 3rd drafts we still have the opportunity to improve on it.

I am therefore expecting that you send me a draft KM and Communication strategy with the understanding that it is still work in progress.
