IT IS WITH GREAT PLEASURE I INTRODUCE TO YOU AND THE NATIONAL GOVERNORS FORUM OUR PROGRAM, THE ELECTRONIC EDUCATION INITIATIVE (E-DON). THE E-DON PROGRAM IS AN INTERNATIONAL PROJECT SET UP TO CREATE WAYS TO ENHANCE OUR ACADEMIC/EDUCATIONAL SECTOR PARTICULARLY AMONGST PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES. - A RELATIVE OVERVIEW OF WHAT PROGRAMS, COURSES AND OR SEMINARS THE STATE
 UNIVERSITY IS INTERESTED IN PURSUING. I.E. VIRTUAL CLASSROOM LECTURE
 EXCHANGES, STUDENT/FACULTY TRAINING CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS, INTERNATIONAL
 COLLEGE TO COLLEGE GRANT COLLABORATIONS, STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMS OR
 ALL OF THE ABOVE SHOULD BE SUBMITTED TO THE OFFICE OF THE COORDINATOR EDON ORG.
- IF NECESSARY WE CAN RECOMMEND AND ASSIST IF NEEDED VIDEO-CONFERENCING EQUIPMENT TO EACH STATE COLLEGE CAMPUS WE DO HAVE TECHNICAL PARTNERS WHO CAN COME ON BOARD TO HELP INSTALL THE STRUCTURES THAT ARE VERY NECESSARY FOR THE EXCHANGE PENDING WHAT ICT HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE ARE ALREADY PRESENT AT YOUR UNIVERSITY.
- A VISIT TO THE UNIVERSITY TO MEET THE VICE CHANCELLOR, DEPUTY VICE CHANCELLOR AND FACULTY/ADMINISTRATION WOULD BE SCHEDULED IN ORDER TO HAVE A MEET AND GREET TO DISCUSS THE PROGRAM, BENEFITS AND FUTURE PLANS OF THE INITIATIVE WITH THE UNIVERSITY THIS WILL HELP ENHANCE THE OBJECTIVES OF THE UNIVERSITY AS IT RELATES TO THE FUTURE OF CLASSROOM EDUCATION ON ITS CAMPUS AS WELL AS ENHANCE THE QUALITY OF THE INSTITUTION'S GRADUATES.
- A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WOULD BE THEN DRAWN AND SIGNED BETWEEN THE PROGRAM AND THE UNIVERSITY ADMINISTRATION, HIGHLIGHTING EACH PARTNER'S ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.

COST IMPLICATION AND PROGRAM OUTLINE:

- THERE IS NO ADMISSION FEE THAT IS TO BE CHARGED TO ANY UNIVERSITY. EACH
 OFFICIAL LETTER WRITTEN TO THE PROGRAM WILL BE SUFFICIENT TO BEGIN A
 CORRESPONDENCE.
- THERE ARE ANNUAL COSTS RELATING TO THE PROCESSING, SCHEDULING AND ORGANIZING OF PROGRAMS AS WELL AS LECTURES, SEMINARS, CERTIFICATION COURSES WHICH WILL VARY PENDING ON TIME, LENGTH, CONTENT AS WELL AS EACH CORRESPONDING UNIVERSITY/INSTITUTION FOR EACH PROGRAM.
- (IF NECESSARY!!) THE PROGRAM CORRESPONDS WITH TECHNICAL PARTNERS BOTH LOCAL AND FOREIGN WHO CAN ASSIST IN EQUIPPING THE UNIVERSITY WITH ICT STRUCTURES (ONLY IF THE UNIVERSITY REQUIRES) NECESSARY TO FULLY UTILIZE THE LINKAGES OF THE PROGRAM. (VIDEO-CONFERENCING IS VERY RELATIVE TO THE LIVE EXCHANGE OF COURSES AND SUFFICIENT BANDWIDTH IS IMPORTANT TO SUSTAIN THE VISUAL AND AUDIO QUALITY DURING EACH EXCHANGE. THIS DEPENDS ON WHAT ALREADY IS PRESENT ON EACH CAMPUS IF THE UNIVERSITY CURRENTLY HAS SUFFICIENT BANDWIDTH AND VIDEO-CONFERENCING EQUIPMENT PRESENT IN CLASSROOM OR CLASSROOMS LABORATORY. THEN THESE COSTS WOULD BE MINIMAL.
- PHYSICAL EXCHANGE AND TRAINING PROGRAMS. THE INITIATIVE WORKS CLOSELY WITH FOREIGN UNIVERSITIES AND INSTITUTIONS OF LEARNING TO BRING BOTH STUDENT AND FACULTY HANDS ON TRAINING PROGRAMS WHICH REQUIRE INDIVIDUALS TO BE PRESENT, THEY RANGE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO AGRICULTURAL PROGRAMS, SCIENCE/TECHNOLOGY AND HEALTHCARE. PENDING ON THE TARGET NEED OF EACH UNIVERSITY. (THE PROGRAM WILL CORRESPOND WITH THE UNIVERSITY INFORMING THEM OF POTENTIAL PROGRAMS/CONFERENCE ABROAD THAT COULD BE OF INTEREST TO THEIR MANAGEMENT, STAFF, FACULTY AND STUDENTS AND OF WHAT COST.
- REPRESENTING THE UNIVERSITY AT INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE FAIRS AND CONFERENCES ENCOURAGING SCHOOLS, STUDENTS AND FACULTY TO VISIT, WORK WITH AND COLLABORATE WITH YOUR UNIVERSITY. THUS INCREASING THE CAMPUS'S INTERNATIONAL PRESENCE.
- CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION AND UNIVERSITY TWIN SYSTEM: A KEY BENEFIT IS THE FACT OF HAVING YOUR STUDENTS ACQUIRE PRESTIGIOUS CERTIFICATES FROM INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITIES AS THE SAME UNIVERSITIES WOULD ANTICIPATE CERTIFICATES FROM YOUR SCHOOL. THIS IS DONE BY CERTAIN PROGRAMS BEING DEVELOPED AND FACULTIES CAN REQUEST THESE PROGRAMS THAT WOULD BE STREAMED LIVE TO THE UNIVERSITY CLASSROOM AFTER THE SCHEDULED TIME OF THE PROGRAM WHICH CAN RANGE ANYWHERE FROM 2-3 TO 4 WEEKS WITH A QUESTION AND ANSWER AND TESTING PHASE. AFTER WHICH STUDENTS AND OR FACULTY WILL RECEIVE CERTIFICATES OF COMPLETION. I.E. OF SUCH PROGRAMS CAN BE IN AGRICULTURE "CROP PRODUCTION" OR IN HEALTHCARE A PROGRAM CAN BE SET UP FOR "HIV/AIDS RESEARCH PROGRAMS OR CANCER RESEARCH SEMINARS".

• GRANTS AND PARTNERSHIPS: ANOTHER KEY BENEFIT PARTICULARLY TO THE UNIVERSITY IS THE AVENUE TO COLLABORATE WITH FOREIGN SCHOOLS ON RESEARCH GRANTS AND PROJECTS. ORGANIZATIONS LIKE THE UNITED STATES AGENCY INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT (USAID), DEPARTMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT (DFID FROM THE UK), MAC-ARTHUR FOUNDATION AND MANY OTHERS. THIS PROGRAM WILL HELP BRIDGE THE GAP AND ASSIST IN COLLABORATIVE MEASURES TO ENABLE SCHOOLS IN DEVELOPED NATIONS KNOW MORE ABOUT YOUR UNIVERSITY AND HOW BEST TO ENGAGE IT IN GRANT PROJECTS AS IT RELATES TO AFRICAHEALTHCARE, ICT, AGRICULTURE, PEACE AND CONFLICT RESOLUTION AND MANY MORE.

NOTE: IF ANY STATE UNIVERSITY DOES NOT HAVE SUFFICIENT ICT INFRASTRUCTURE PRESENT ON THEIR CAMPUS THE PROGRAM IS WILLING TO TAKE A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF THE SCHOOL AND ASSIST IN PROCURING, CONSTRUCTING AND INSTALLING ALL NECESSARY STRUCTURES FOR THE INITIATIVE TO TAKE ROOT INCLUDING BUILDING OF A MULTI-MEDIA ICT CENTRE FOR THIS PURPOSE. PENDING FUNDING FOR ALL THE AMENITIES AND RELATED COST TO THE PROJECT ARE CATERED FOR BY EITHER THE INSTITUTION OR THE STATE DEPARTMENT FOR EDUCATION.

GENERAL BENEFITS OF THE PROGRAM:

- SCIENCES, ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY: IT (INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY)
- THE SOCIAL SCIENCES: POLITICAL SCIENCE, SOCIOLOGY AND OTHER MAJOR TOPICS AND SUBJECTS THAT ARE OF INTEREST TO THE PARTICIPATING UNIVERSITIES.
- BANKING AND FINANCE: STOCK MARKET RESEARCH AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.
- HEALTHCARE: HIV (PREVENTION/SEX EDUCATION) CPR CLASSES (LIFE SUPPORT PRACTICES)
- HISTORY, CULTURE AND TRADITIONS.
- GENERAL SOCIETAL AND GLOBAL ISSUES RANGING FROM POVERTY ERADICATION TO FOOD SECURITY, PEACE/CONFLICT RESOLUTION AND CLIMATIC CHANGE AND SO MUCH **MORE**

THIS DRAFT IS SET UP AS A BRIEF SUMMARY AND IS NOT BINDING, BUT ASSIST TO ITEMIZE THE STRUCTURE OF THE PARTNERSHIP/MOU WHICH CAN AND WILL BE MORE DETAILED TO TAILOR TO THE GOVERNOR'S FORUM AS WELL AS THE STATEINSTITUTION'S NEED.

OUR GOAL IS TO BRING AN INTERNATIONAL COMPONENT TO OUR STATES, THEIR INSTITUTION'S AND OUR COMMUNITY, INTRODUCING OUR CLASSROOMS, STUDENTS AND FACULTY TO THE WORLD IN A DIFFERENT WAY. ENHANCING THE INSTITUTION'S DEGREE VALUE NATIONALLY AND GLOBALLY AS WELL AS SHOWCASES THE ADMINISTRATION'S LEADERSHIP IN AFRICA AND INDEED THE WORLD.

THE BENEFITS TO GOVERNORS FORUM:

- COLLABORATION ON CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMS FOR SENIOR STAFF OF STATE GOVERNMENTS AND THE SECTARIAT.

ROLE EXPECTATIONS FOR THE e-DON PROGRAM IN COLLABORATION WITH THE NGF WILL INCLUDE BUT WILL NOT BE LIMITED TO:

 THE e-DON PROGRAM WILL WORK ON MAKING SORE EVERY LINKAGE AND CONNECTIVITY IS DONE IN ACCORDANCE WITH NUC STANDARDS.
- WE WILL OVER SEE THE CONSISTENT AND STANDARD OF THE PROGRAM IN EACH STATE
 AS WELL AS FOLLOW UP WITH THEIR CORRESPONDING SCHOOLS ABRAOD MAKING
 SURE EVERY SESSION IS ADHERED TO PUNCTUALLY.
- WE WILL ENCOURAGE GRANTS AND PARTNERHSIPS WITH BOTH THE NGF AND THE STATES INSTITUTIONS FROM FOREIGN SCHOOLS WISHING TO GAIN ACCESS TO PARTNER WITH NIGERIA AND HER STATES ON A VAIRETY OF GRANT PROGRAMS THAT RANGE FROM AGRICULTURE TO HEALTHCARE AND SO ON.










Mission

PRESENTATION TO THE GOVERNORS FORUM ABUJA

I would like to begin by first of all appreciating the entire Management and staff of the Governors Forum particularly its Director General Mr A.D Okauru for giving me and the Electronic Education Initiative (e-DON) this opportunity to be before you today. I bring greetings from our brothers and sisters in Diaspora (of which I too am a part of) particularly in North America the United States. I will go right into the business of why I am here which is to officially present our program the Electronic education Initiative (e-DON) and seek your support and collaboration as we propose to introduce this initiative to our state institutions of learning. As we all move to find avenues to enhance our nation's education system while at the same time working to create sustainable linkages with our Diaspora all over the world, it is necessary to find new and viable ways to do just that, particularly in today's ICT driven society.

Ladies and Gentlemen I am here to affirm to you what all Nigerians both in the Diaspora and at home feel, which is "IT IS TIME FOR A CHANGE! IT IS TIME FOR A POSITIVE CHANGE IN OUR SOCIETY AND WE ALL CAN MAKE THAT CHANGE HAPPEN, TOGETHER" Today I present to you the Electronic Education Initiative Program otherwise known as e-DON. The e-DON Initiative is a cross cultural cross Atlantic project set up to create and sustain linkages between our institutions of learning in the developed nations and developing countries. The program is aimed at enhancing our nation's institutions of learning by means of knowledge transfer, in this age of multi-media advancement our country and her states cannot lack behind others in the way we provide quality education to our future leaders. The world we live in is gradually becoming a global village with the introduction of the internet, information and communication between two ethnicities is but a click away. Now Nigerians abroad can conveniently communicate with their families not just by regular mail and phone but now can video-conference and communicate in real time with their loved ones. This being said one thing our diaspora all over the world have championed is the ability for each of them to do their individual best to bring about positive change to our country in any and every way. I am here today to introduce to you one of the ways we can and will impact the Nigerian Society, our youth and our institutions of learning that is by way of the Electronic Education Program.

Now Global experts, academics and professionals from nations all around the world can partner with their peers here in Nigeria by way of live video interaction to give up to date and broader information on several academic and non-academic subject matters that range from Agriculture, Healthcare/Medicine to Computer Information Systems as well as Engineering and even Cultural seminars and workshops that can be shared between schools both at home and abroad.

The e-DON Initiative is partnering with several government and private organizations nationally and internationally in order to give the best variety of programs to our schools both at the national level and now at the state level. Universities from the United States and the United Kingdom have indicated in writing their willingness to work with the Initiative as many of them view its potential as viable, sustainable and not to mention cost effective as well as it being secure. The Nigerian Ambassador to the United States Amb Ade Adefuye wrote to Nigeria's Minister of Education in support of this initiative.

OUR REQUEST:

What this program proposes with the support and collaboration of the Governors Forum and the States is to set up an "Electronic Education Media Center" in each of our State Universities possibly beginning with pilot centers one in a University in each of our geo-political zones. This centre will be used as the school campus international classroom centre where students and faculty will go during Live video-conferences over internet. The centre will be equipped with State of the art ICT structures to enable students and faculty have international LIVE in-classroom video-conferencing exchanges, as well as internet use and other multi-media needs. The Program does not necessarily aim to introduce multimedia technology to our state institutions of learning as some of them may already have some level of ICT infrastructure on their campuses thanks to both government and private intervention in some of the schools. What the program aims to do is to enhance our education system by way of using the structures to have programs that will work for us. With the e-DON Initiative's array of international schools and affiliates now we don't have to take all our youth to the world for them to have a global perspective on different subject matter we can now bring the world to them. This in turn will enhance our country's future by way of internationalizing our campuses giving our graduates a global view on several subjects. This program also allows each state's Diaspora indigene to find ways to give back to his community as we know or can imagine it is not always cost effective for our Diaspora to leave their adopted homes to come back to their community to participate in certain lectures, seminars or programs the risk involved in just travelling alone and leaving their loved ones behind are at times a deterrent in getting a lot of our people to come home. That being said there is an alternative I am happy to inform the forum that the Nigerians in Diaspora Organization - Americas has officially partnered with the e-DON Program endorsing the initiative's objectives as not just cost effective but sustainable and functional if properly implemented which of course it is and will continue to be properly implemented. The Organization that houses Nigerian experts, academics and professionals have written their members informing them of the program getting them ready to be of use when we call. We are requesting interested States who are interested in this Initiative can make this known through the NGF and we are more than willing to visit each interested state and their institutions. Support for travel and accommodation would be highly appreciated.

COST IMPLICATION:

The practicability and cost of this program to each state Government, the e-DON Initiative and the State university/institutions of learning will vary on several factors namely:

- Current state of ICT Structures at the Schools.
- What level or size of a Multi Media centre and its coverage each state would want/earmark for its institution.
- Location of each School: Location is important as there is a need for the Multi-Media centre to be in proximity to a fiber-network which is needed to give proper, functional and clear (image and audio) video interaction quality.
- Other factors of concern can and would be ironed out between the program and the institutions during feasibility studies of the campuses to ascertain a comprehensive cost implication of the project.

As it relates to overall cost we are requesting collaborations amongst all parties the States, the Governors Forum, the e-DON Initiative and the institutions be drawn up where financial and other factors can be shared between the Governors Forum and the Management of the Program. Allowing all parties identify what each brings to the table to actualize this program's success. The e-DON Initiative has an abundance of resource persons as well as institutions around the world primarily in the United States and the United Kingdom who are ready to come on board to give our students and faculty class the best of foreign knowledge transfer as they can. Also institutions abroad are equally anticipating hearing back from our faculty and student class.

This being said funding is our major challenge as some experts and academics abroad may want some stipend for their time others may do it for free but outside this, what we need are the Classrooms and ICT Structures. It is our request if our proposal is considered that funding is made available to the program through the either state governments or through intervention funding from donor agencies working with the NGF on education. Other costs include primarily technical partners who will bring the structures to the schools as well as consultancy costs and seminar costs which are incorporated as stated in our proposal. The NGF will receive 30% of the consultancy cost per institution per state as facilitators.

Organizations such as Galaxy Backbone PLC have assured of the practicability and viability of this program and when issues that cause worry rise we can overcome most of them an example being Power there are several options that we have identified that can and will help curb the problem 1) Being the use of Inverters to help sustain power during the sessions. 2) Back-UP Generators this is lesser of a choice as this would entail the consistent purchase of diesel or petrol to power the structures, never the less it is an option. 3) Solar powered Battery cells though expensive it is easy to maintain and with the abundance of sunshine this is also viable alternative.

Galaxy Backbone have worked and are working with the Ministry of Education, the National Universities Commission as well as other Government agencies to bring about positive changes to our workplace through the ease of use of Information and Communication Technology. After meetings with their IT Project

and Business Manager the Organization I believe is more than capable to bring this project alive to each and every state institution when we are called upon.

The Electronic Education Initiative was adopted in 2010 and has since made giant strides in achieving the goals it set out to achieve but just like everything else in life the project has had one or two obstacles one of which is simply Change. Change is something that any community finds hard to adapt even if its change for the better. Another obstacle has been funding though we have positive collaborations with both the public and private sector the project is in its infancy stage and needs all the support it can get. I would like to take this opportunity to mention and thank just a few organizations we are currently collaborating with.

There by allowing our nation's graduates to also travel abroad and have their degree be of higher value and repute.

I cannot go without mentioning Prof Julius Okojie of the National Universities Commission, Dr Mahmud Kazaure of the NBTE and Prof Muhammad Junaid of the NCCE and so many others. Allow me to add, the e-DON program will showcase Nigeria State Governments, their Universities as well as your Diaspora around the world as innovators as we showcase how the greatest country on the continent (Nigeria) positively utilizes ICT with our own human capital both at home and abroad to impact society.

In time programs like this will find avenues to not only sustain linkages with our diaspora but also create means for their eventual return home for as they consistently and actively communicate and collaborate with their state institutions virtually and or physically in time this can entice their gradual and hopefully permanent relocation home.
