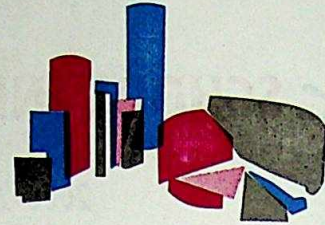

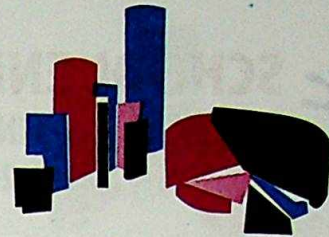
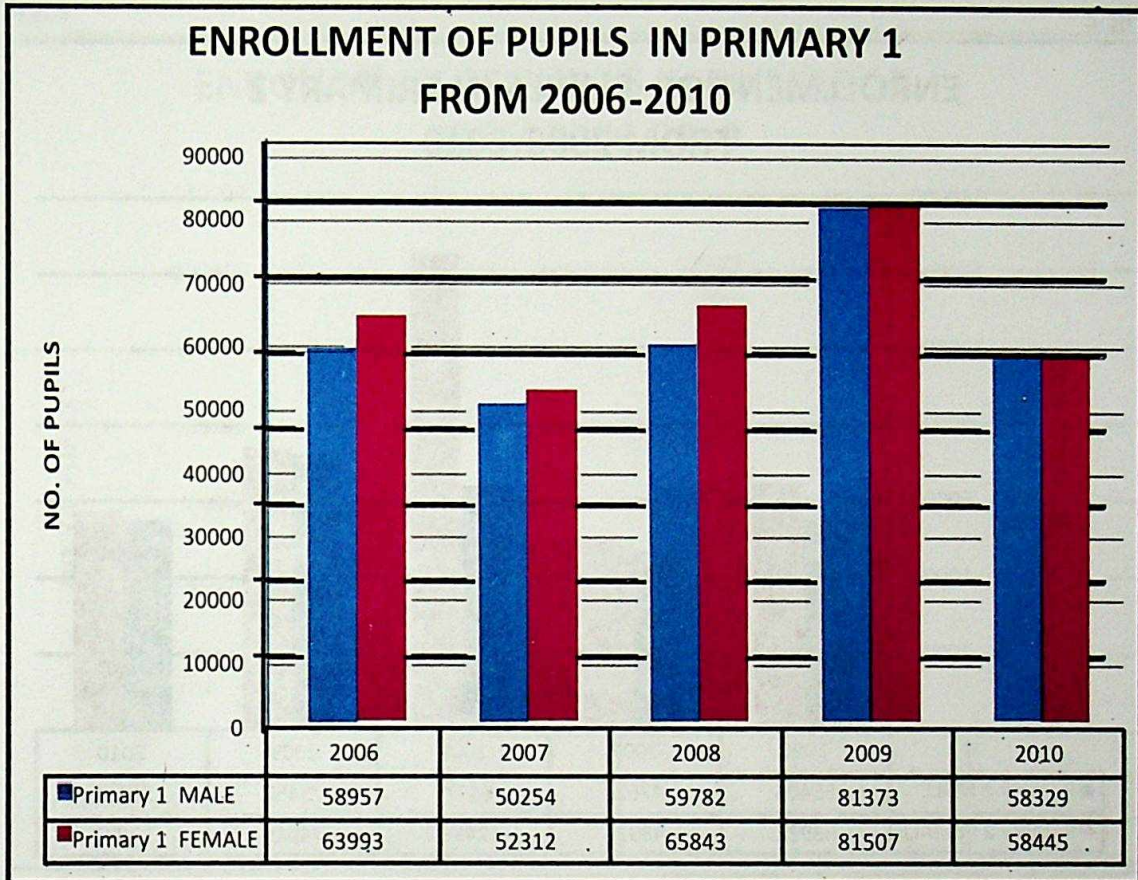

From fig.1 above, the chart showed an irregular trend in both male and female enrollment over the years under review. However, the male and female Pupils recorded highest enrollments in 2009, with a total of 81,373 and 81,507 respectively. Also, 2007 recorded the lowest intake of both sexes with 50,254 male and 52,312 female Pupils .

Summarily, 2009 recorded the highest enrollment of Pupils with a total of 162,880 while 2007 had the lowest enrollment of Pupils with a total of 102,566 Pupils .

2006-2010

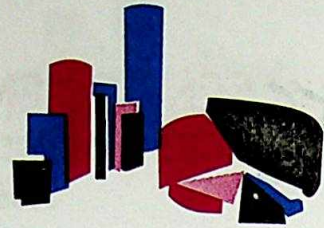

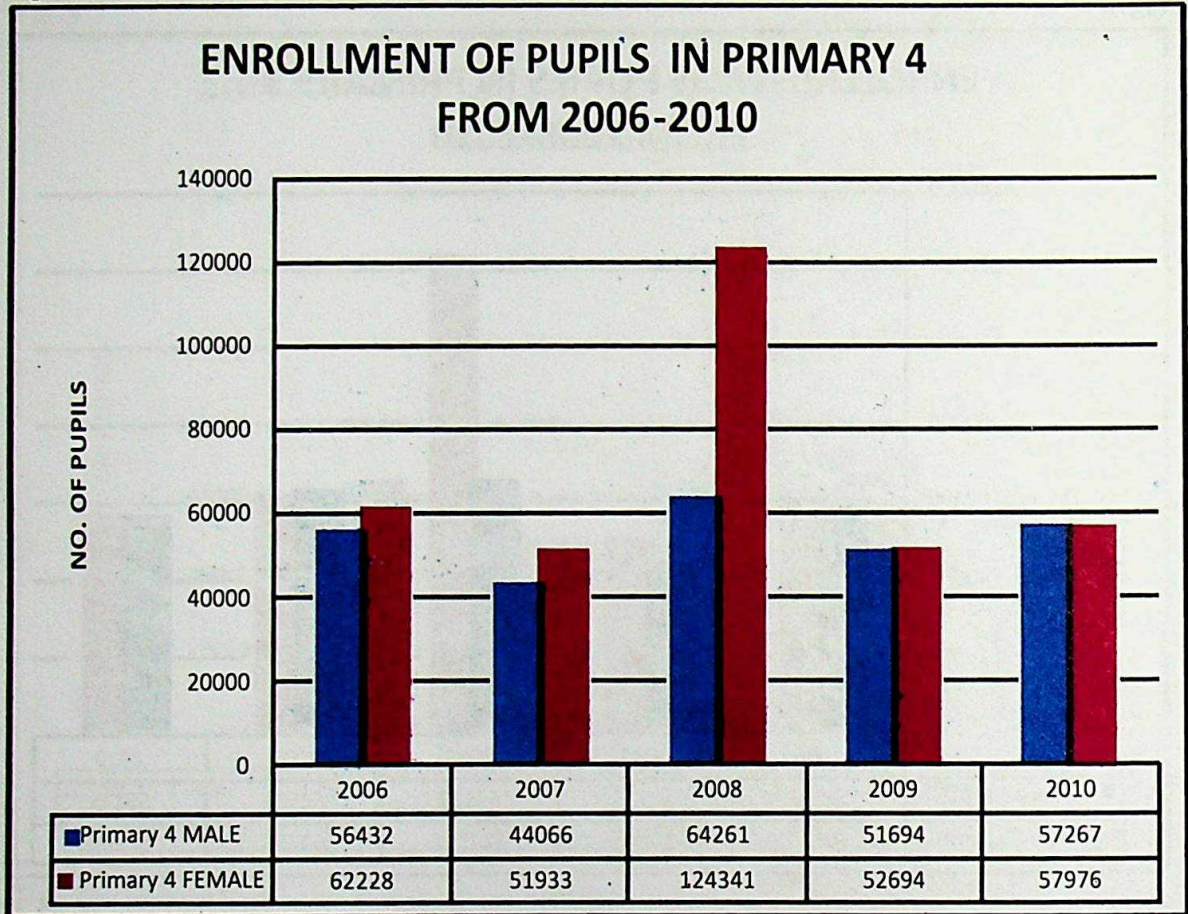

However, the male and female Pupils recorded highest enrollments in 2008, with a total of 64,261 and 124,341 respectively. Also, 2007 recorded the lowest intake of both sex with 44,066 male and 51,933 female Pupils.

Summarily, 2008 recorded the highest enrollment of Pupils with a total of 188,602 while 2007 had the lowest enrollment of Pupils with a total of 95,999 Pupils.



SCHOOL ENROLLMENT BY SEX AND CLASS IN ANAMBRA STATE 2006-2010

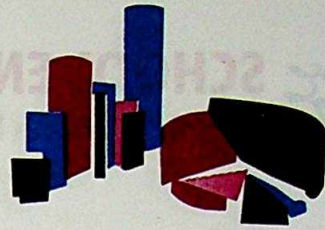

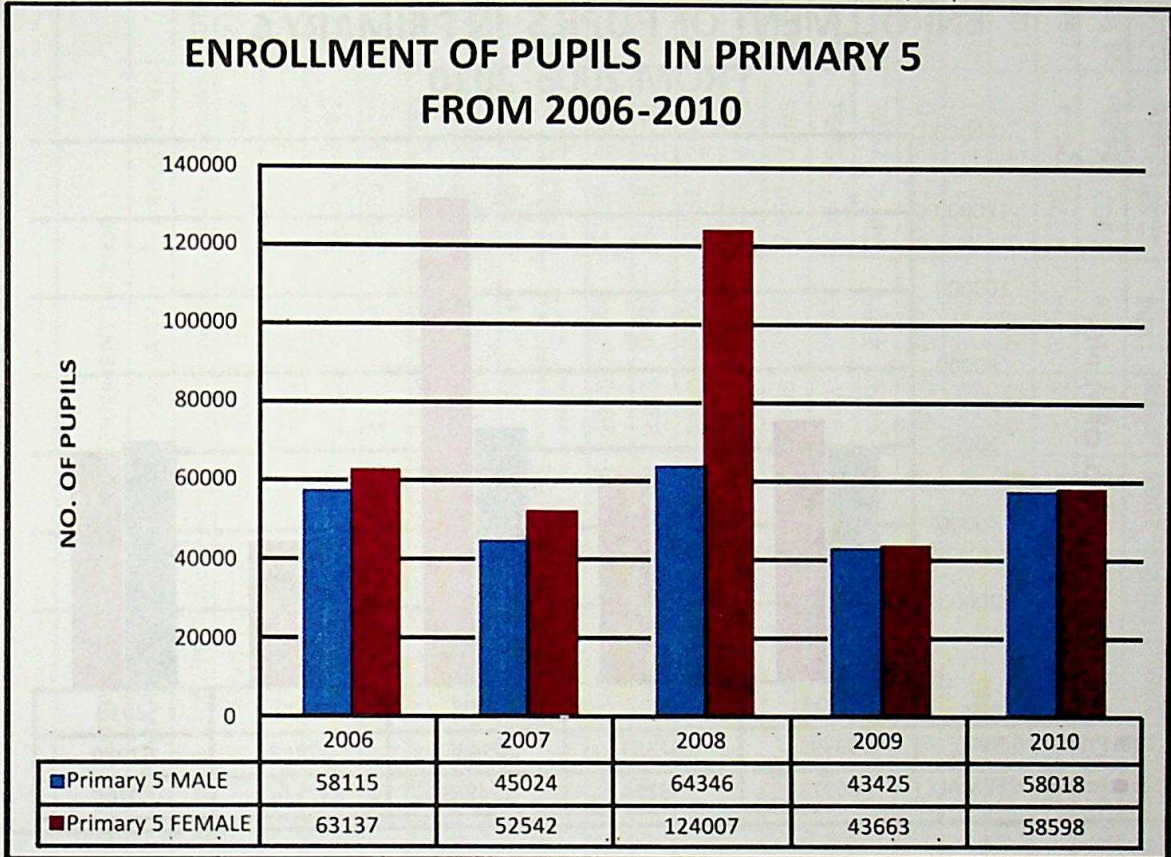

However, the male and female Pupils recorded highest enrollments in 2008, with a total of 64,346 and 124,007 respectively. Also, 2009 recorded the lowest intake of both sex with 43,425 male and 43,663 female Pupils. Summarily, 2008 recorded the highest enrollment of Pupils with a total of 188,353 while 2007 had the lowest enrollment of Pupils with a total of 87,088 Pupils.



SCHOOL ENROLLMENT BY SEX AND CLASS IN ANAMBRA STATE 2006-2010

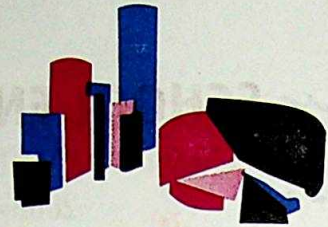

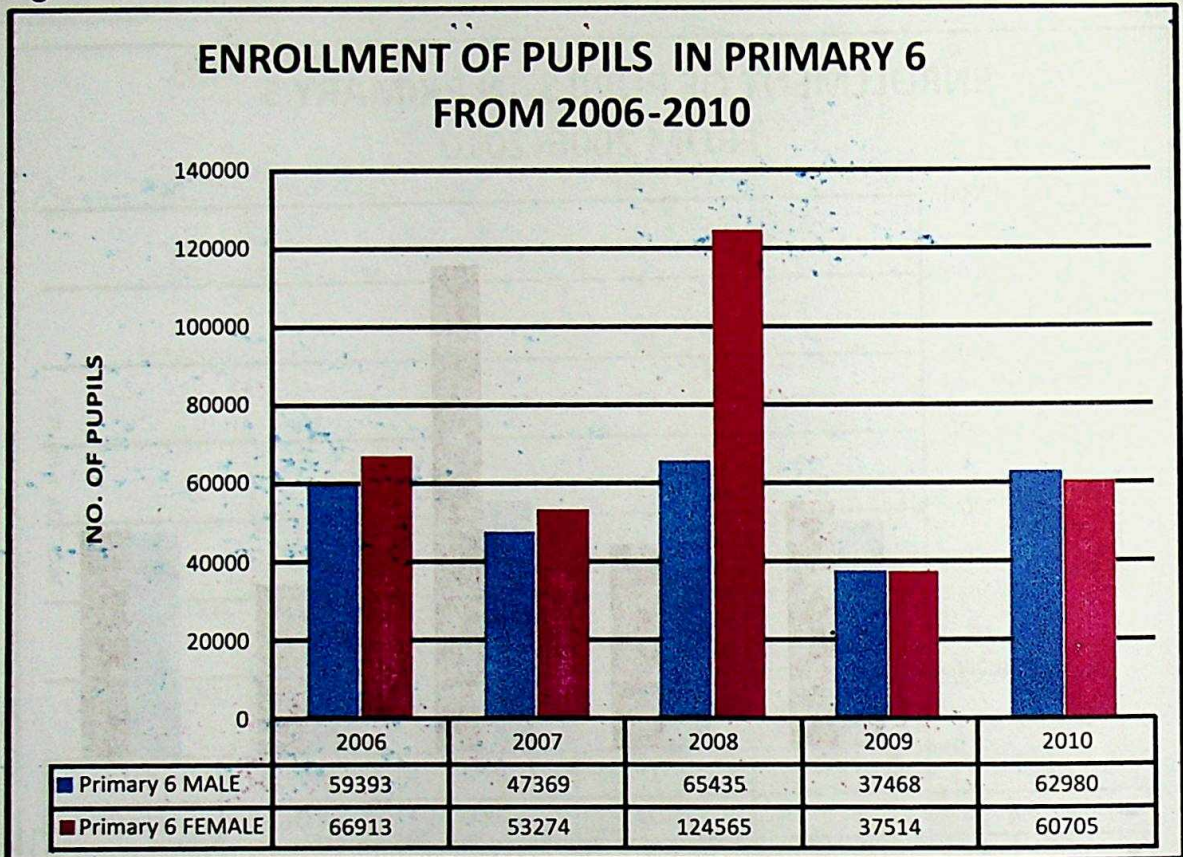

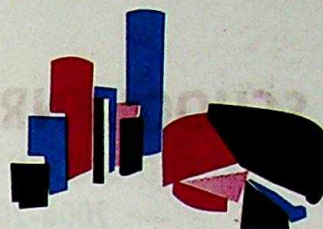

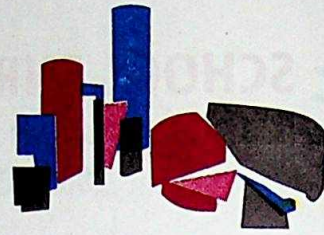
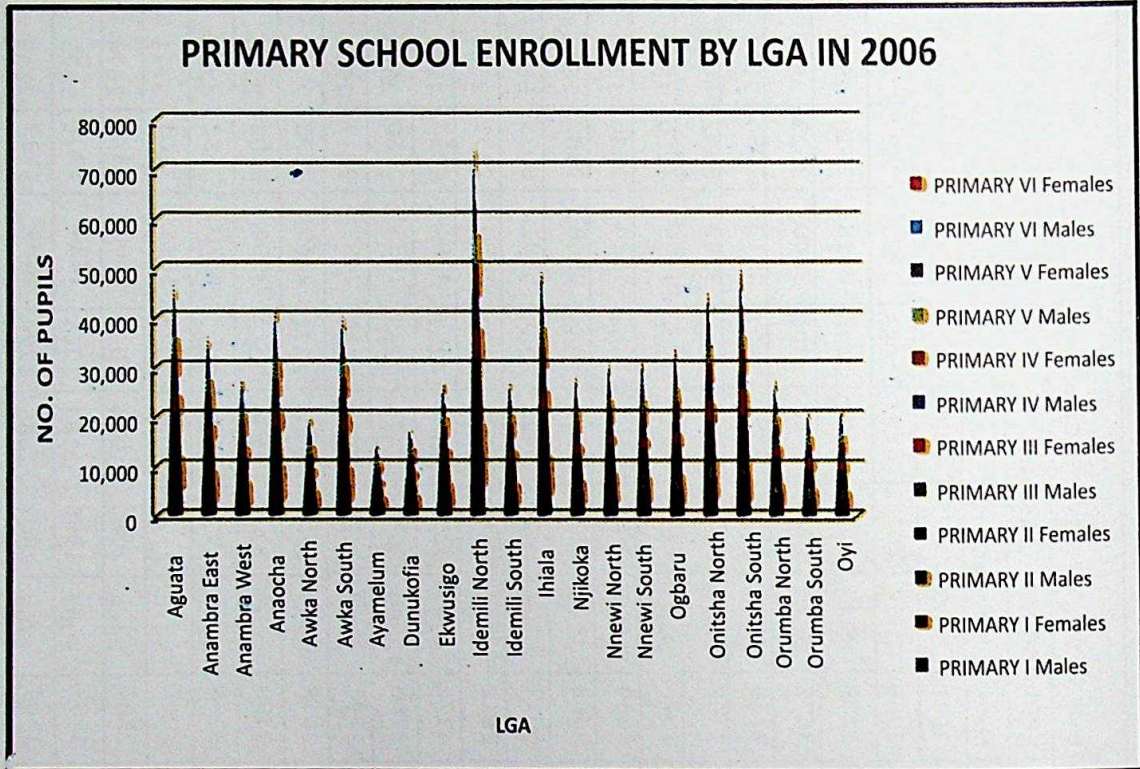

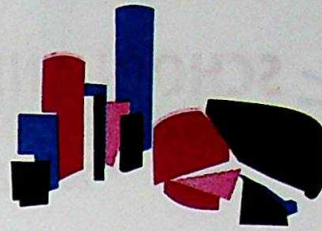

SCHOOL ENROLLMENT BY SEX AND CLASS IN ANAMBRA STATE 2006-2010

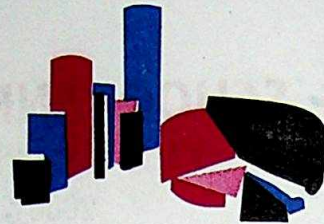

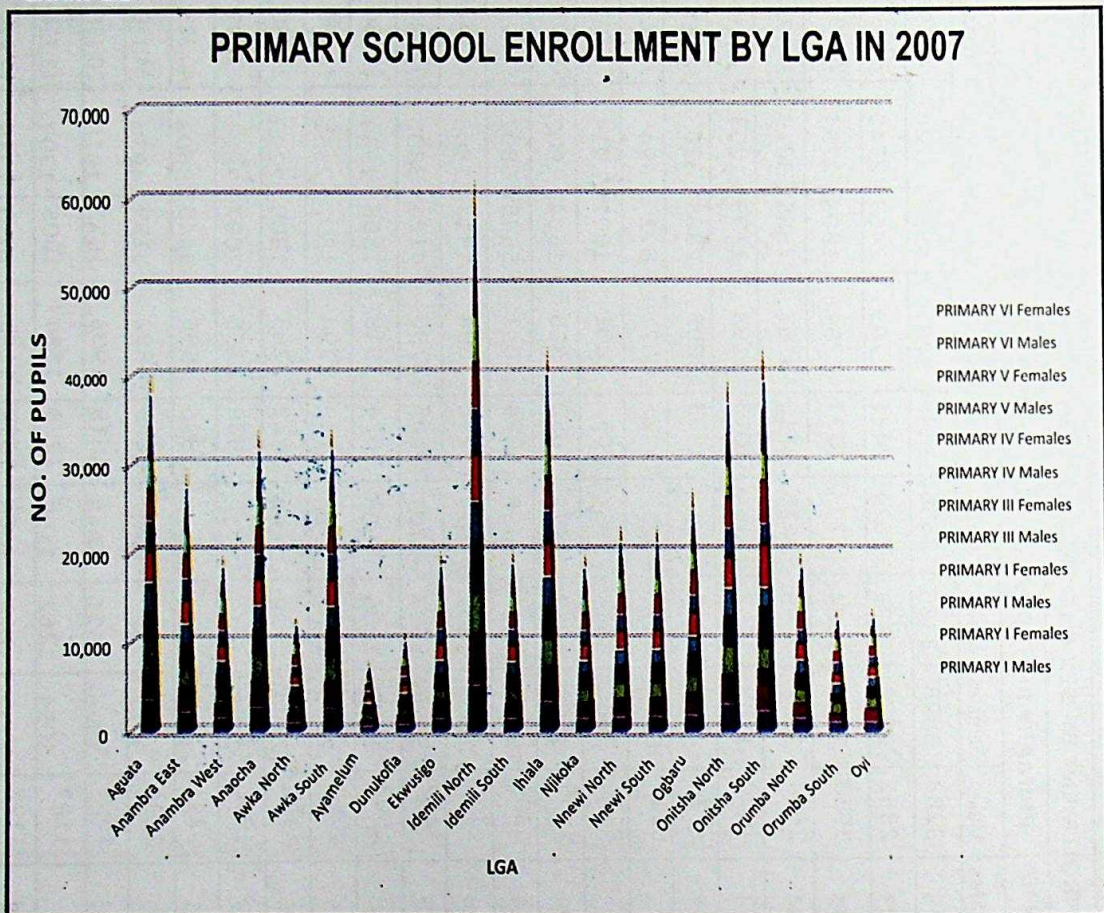


Chart 2.2 showed that Idemili North recorded the highest number of the enrollment while Ayamelum recorded the lowest.

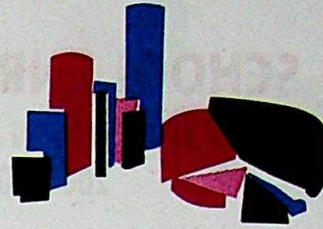

SCHOOL ENROLLMENT BY SEX AND CLASS IN ANAMBRA STATE 2006-2010

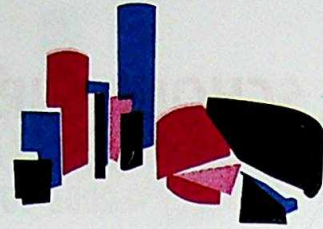
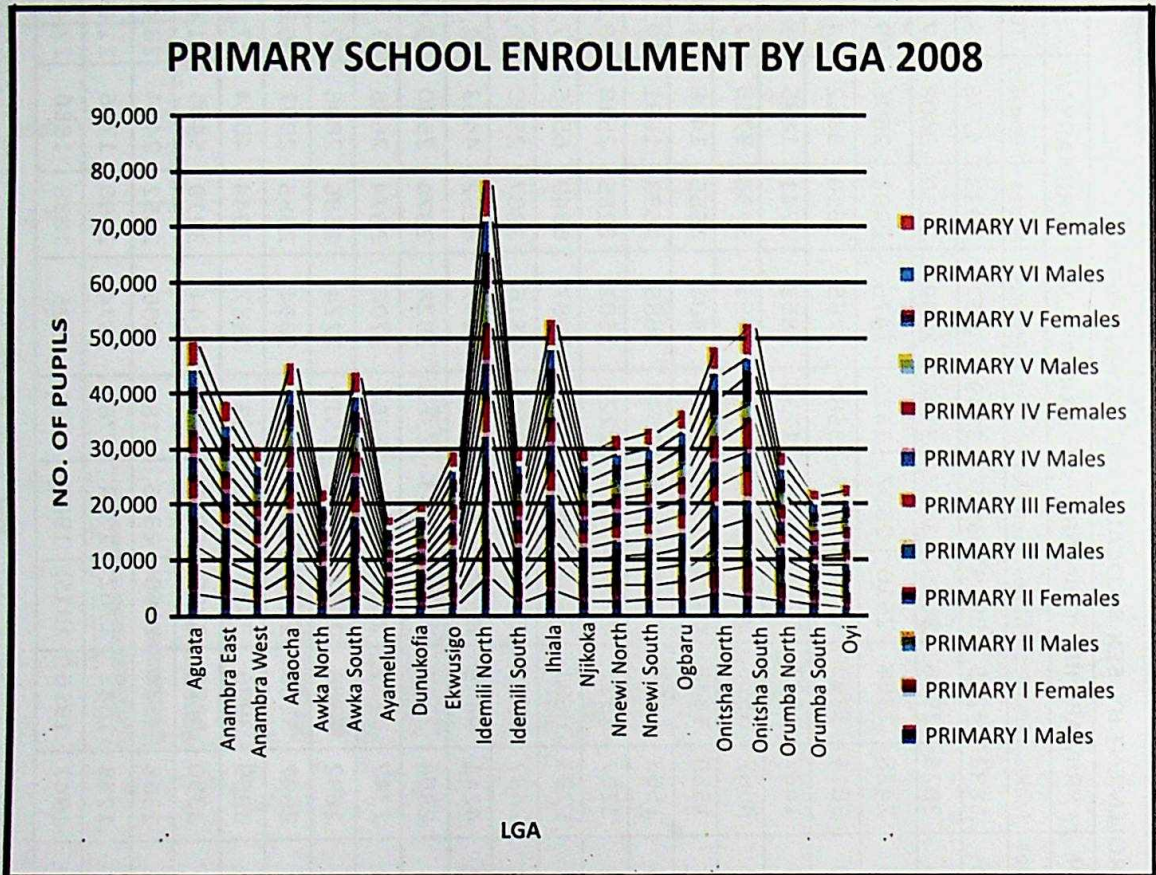

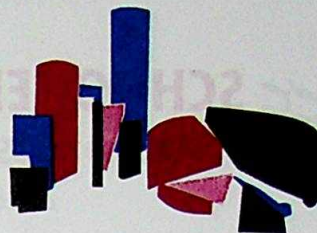

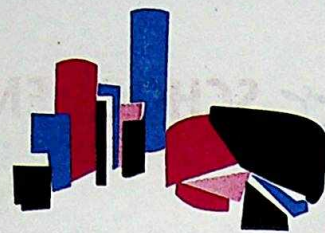
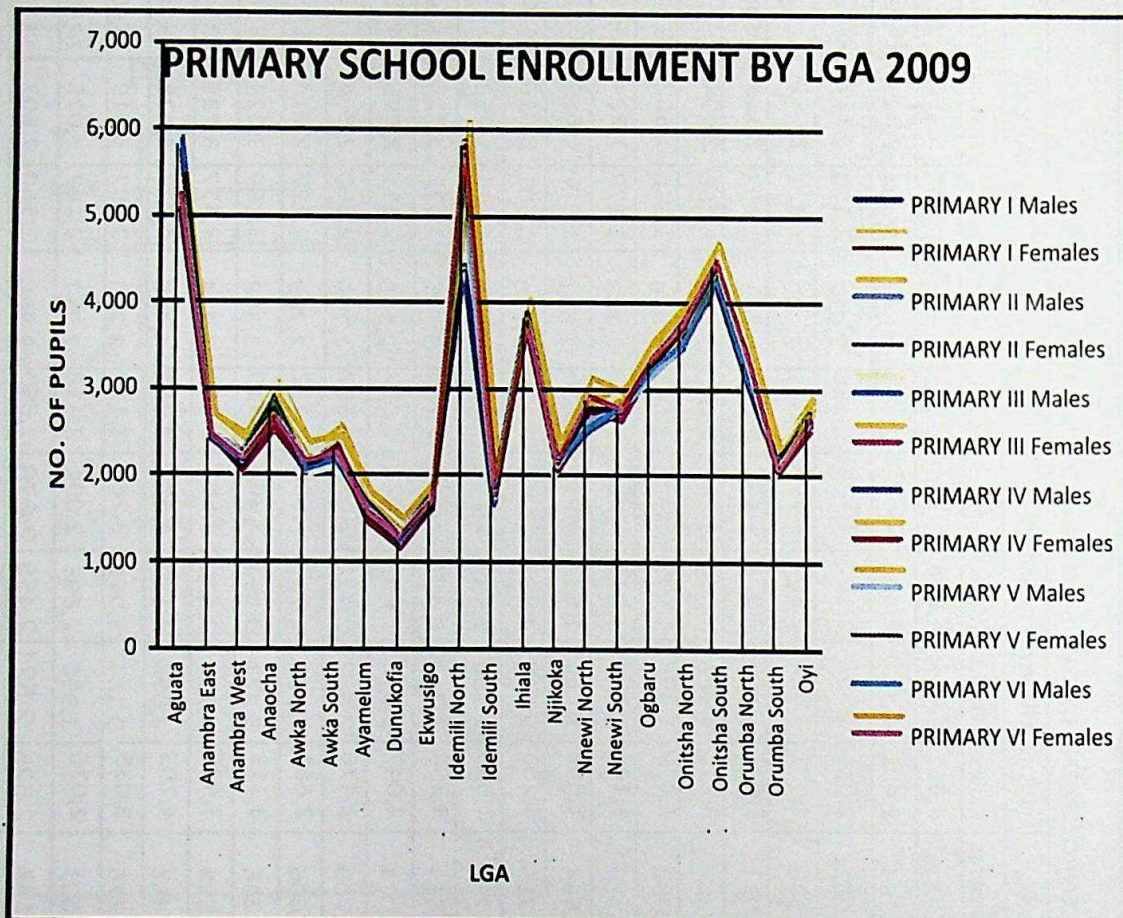

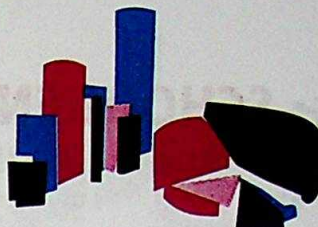

SCHOOL ENROLLMENT BY SEX AND CLASS IN ANAMBRA STATE 2006-2010

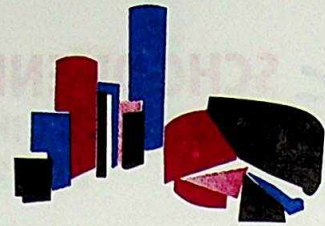

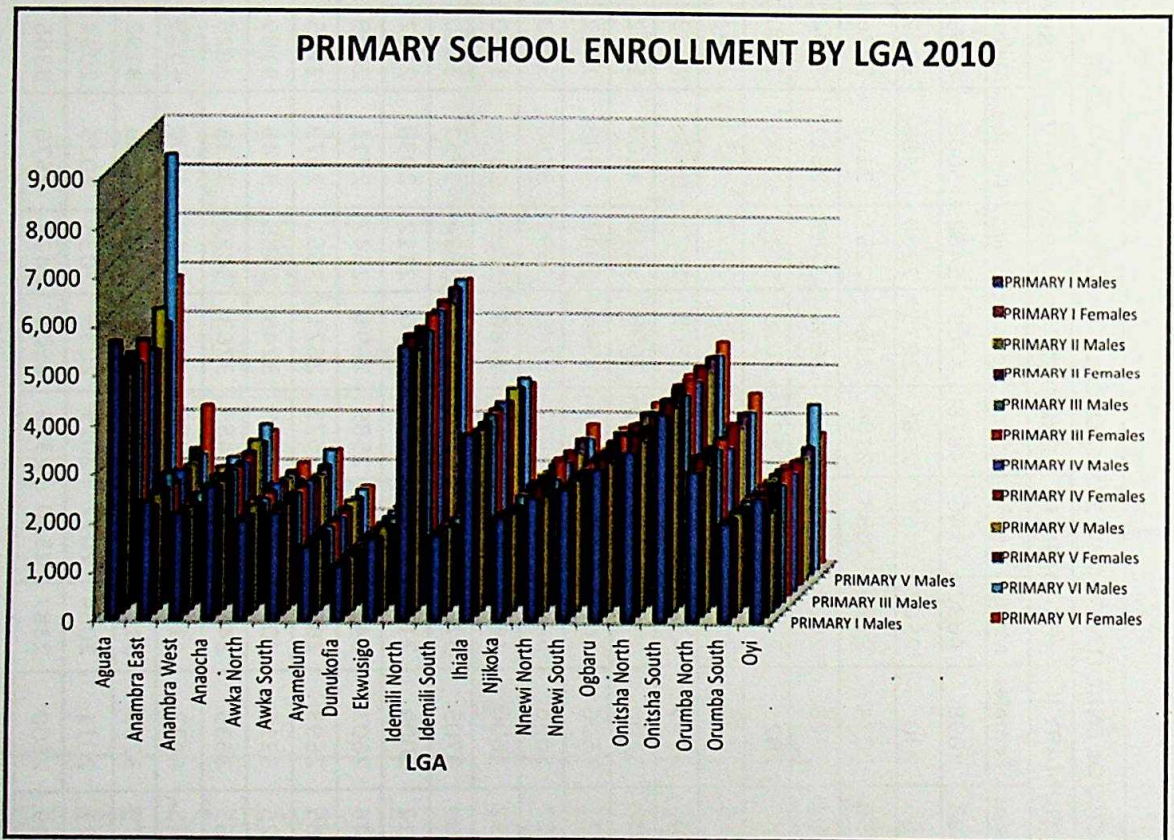


Chart 2.5 showed that Idemili North recorded the highest number of the enrollment while Dunukofia recorded the lowest.



SCHOOL ENROLLMENT BY SEX AND CLASS IN ANAMBRA STATE 2006-2010

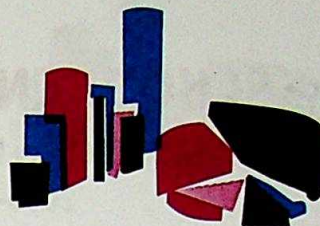

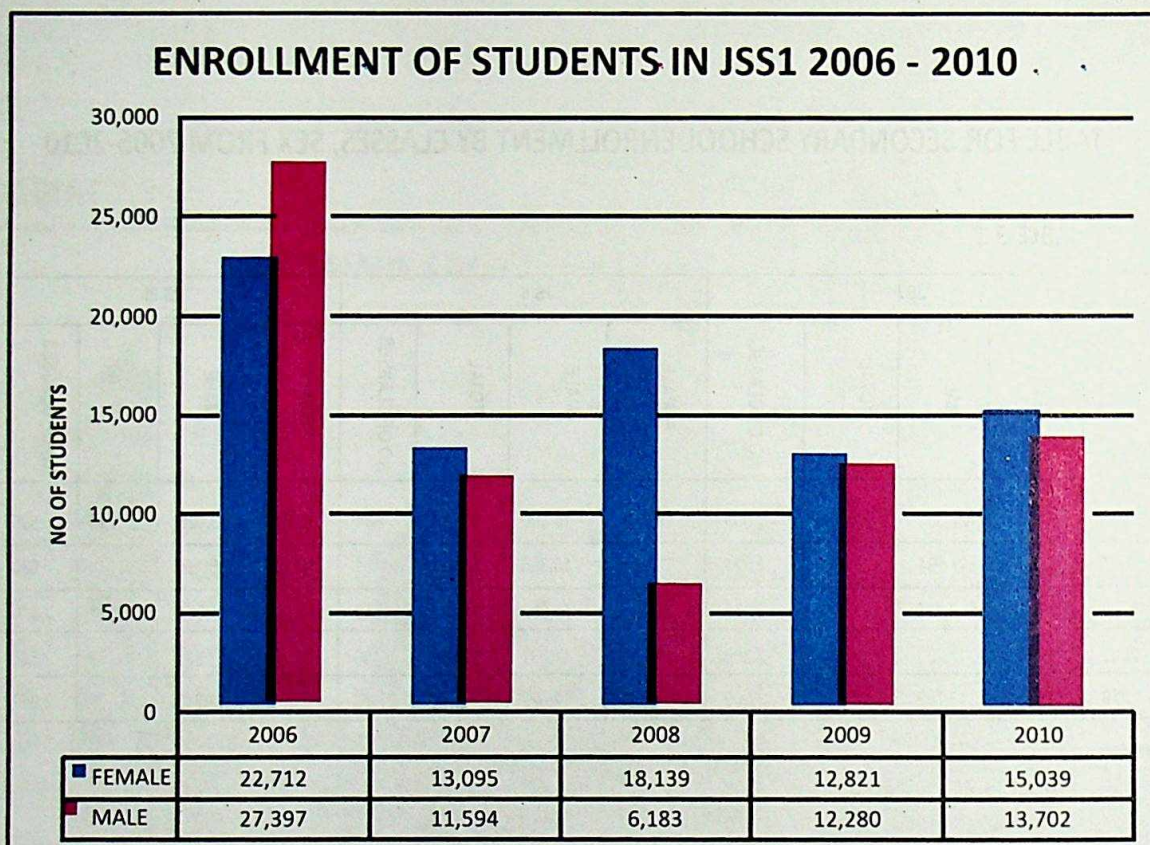
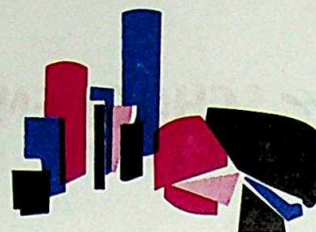

2006-2010



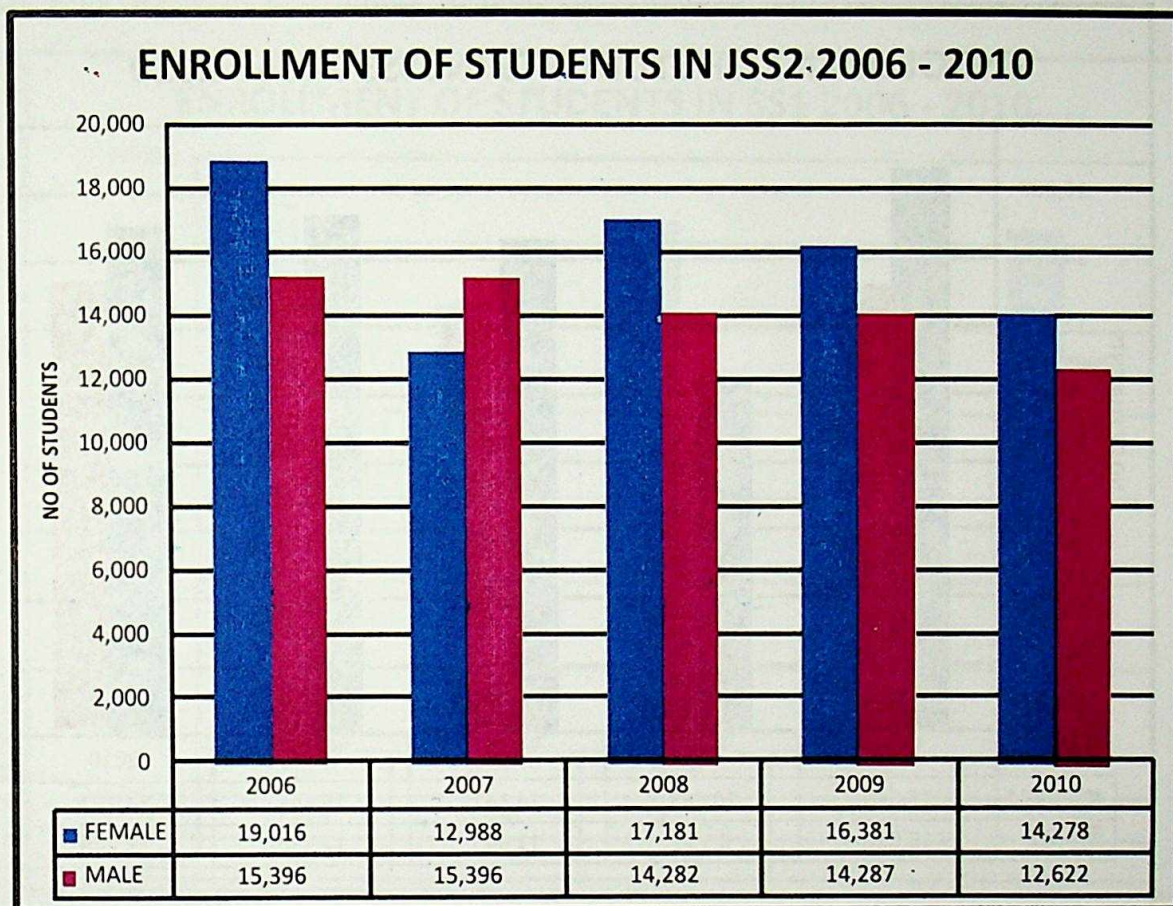
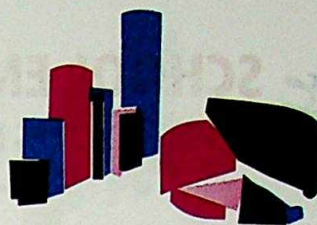
From the above chart, it was observed that the male recorded the highest enrollment of students in 2006 with a total of 27,397 students and a decline of 57.7% from 2006 to 2007 and also 47% decrease from 2007 to 2008. There was a significant increase of 98.6% in male enrollment from 2008 to 2009, while 2009 to 2010 recorded 11.6% increase.

However, the female recorded highest enrollment in 2006, with a total of 22,712 students and lowest in 2009 with 12,821 students. The chart showed irregular trend over the years.

Generally, female enrollment exceeded the male over the years with exception of 2006. Furthermore, 2006 recorded the highest enrollment of students with a total of 50,109 while 2008 had the lowest enrollment of students with a total of 24,322 students.

The male recorded the same number of enrollment in 2006 and 2007, with a total of 15,396 students each and lowest in 2010 with 12,622 students.

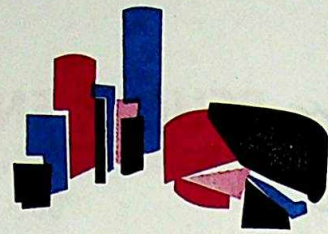
Summarily, 2006 recorded the highest enrollment of students with a total of 34,412 while 2010 had the lowest enrollment of students with a total of 26,900 students



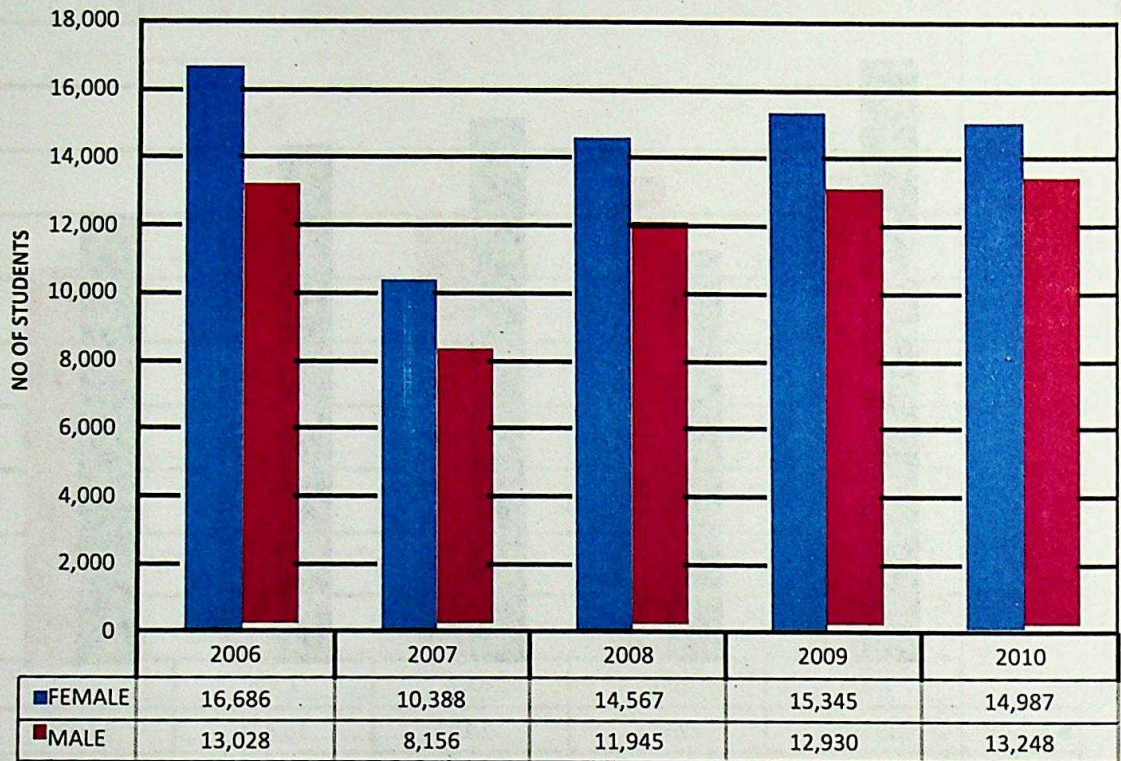
SCHOOL ENROLLMENT

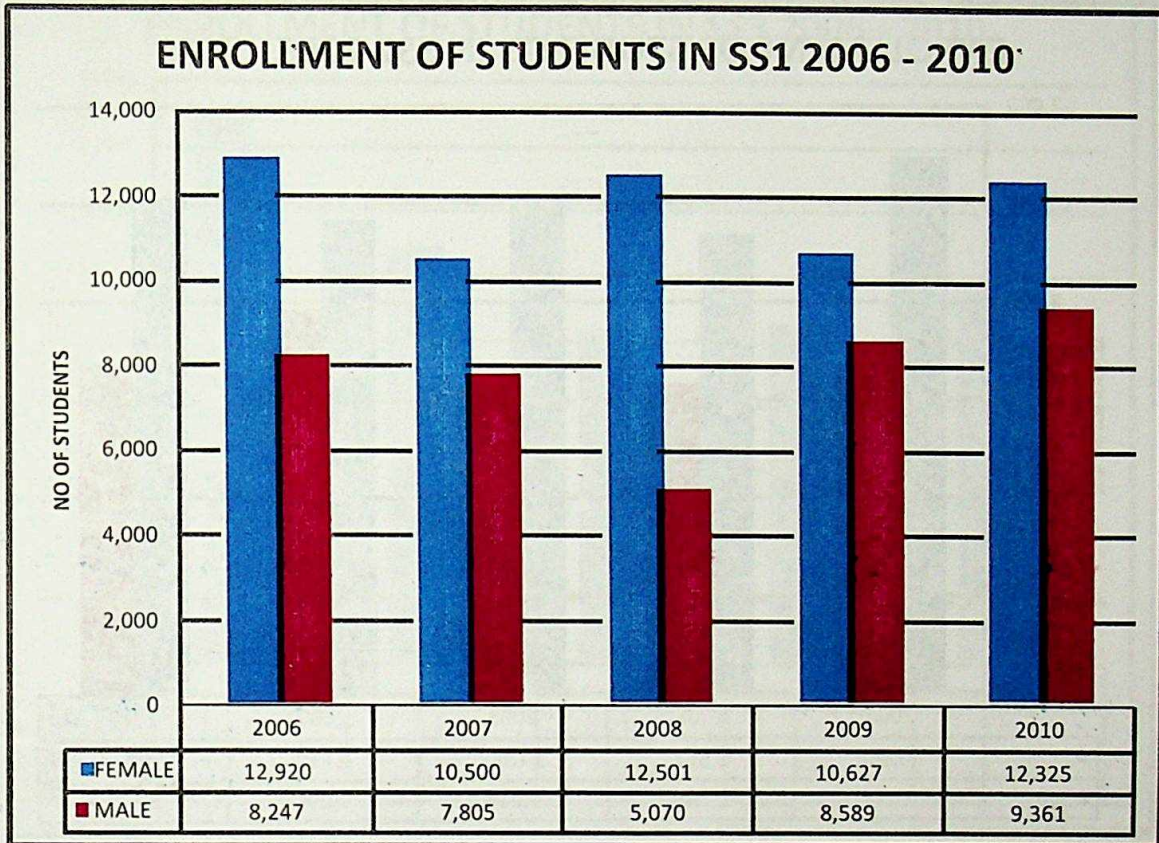
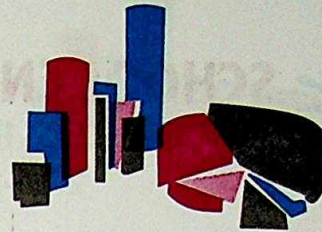
Summarily, 2006 recorded the highest enrollment of students with a total of 29,714 while 2007 had the lowest enrollment of students with a total of 18,544 students.

2006-2010



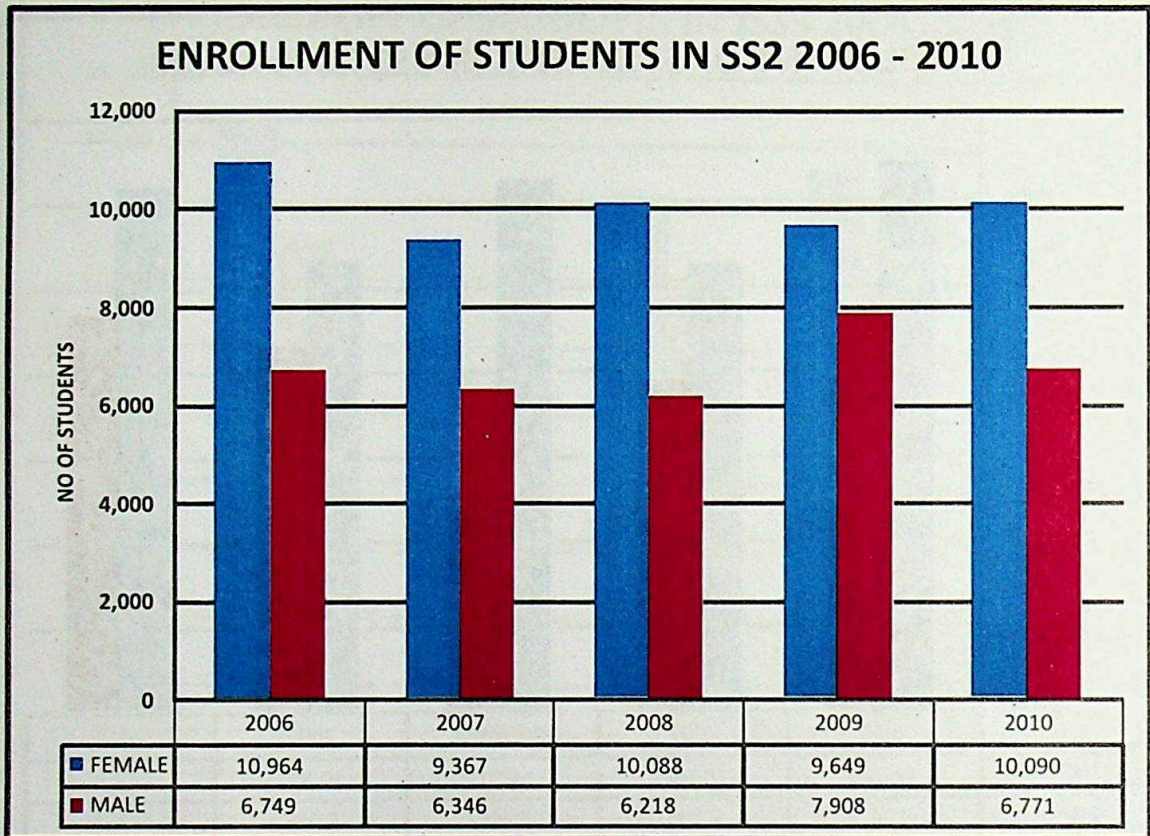
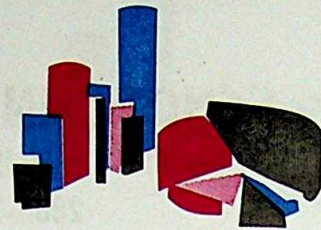

SCHOOL ENROLLMENT BY SEX AND CLASS IN ANAMBRA STATE 2006-2010

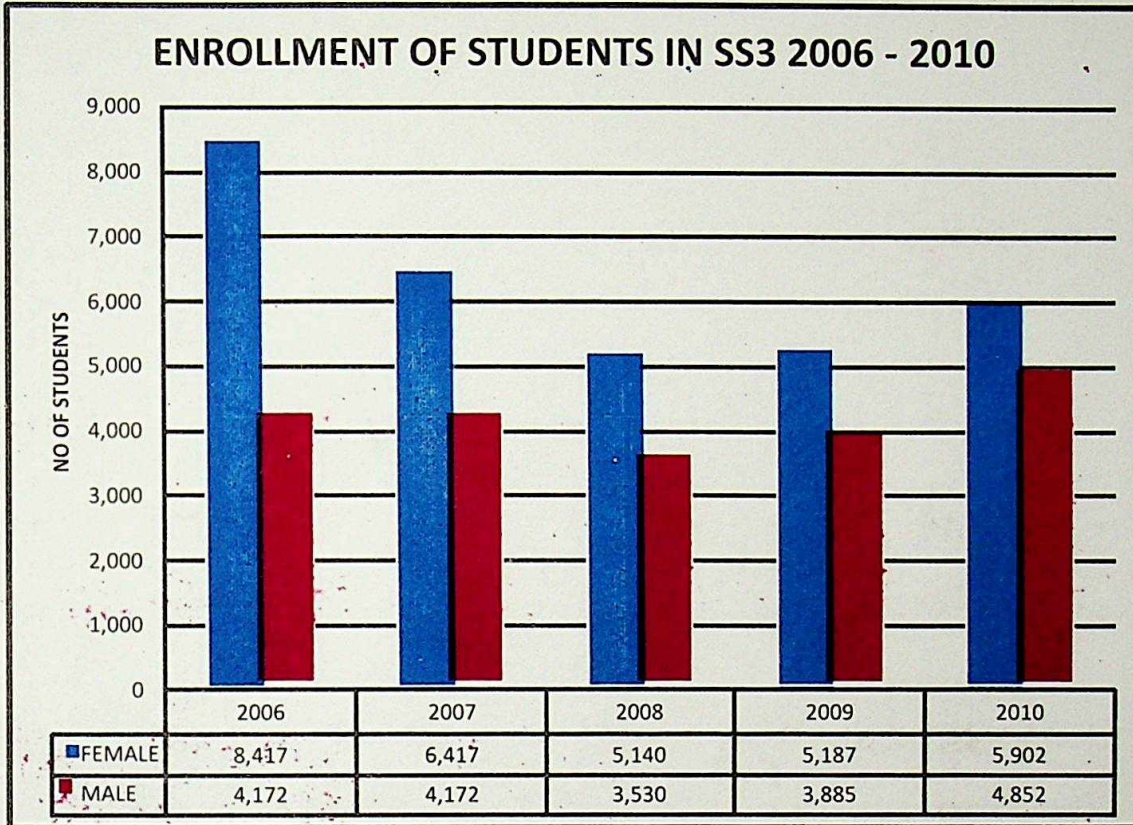
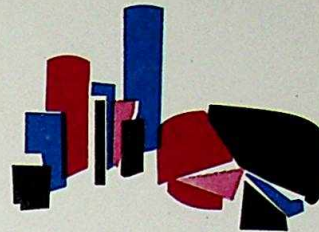
