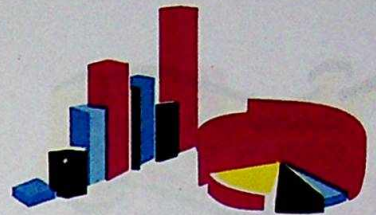


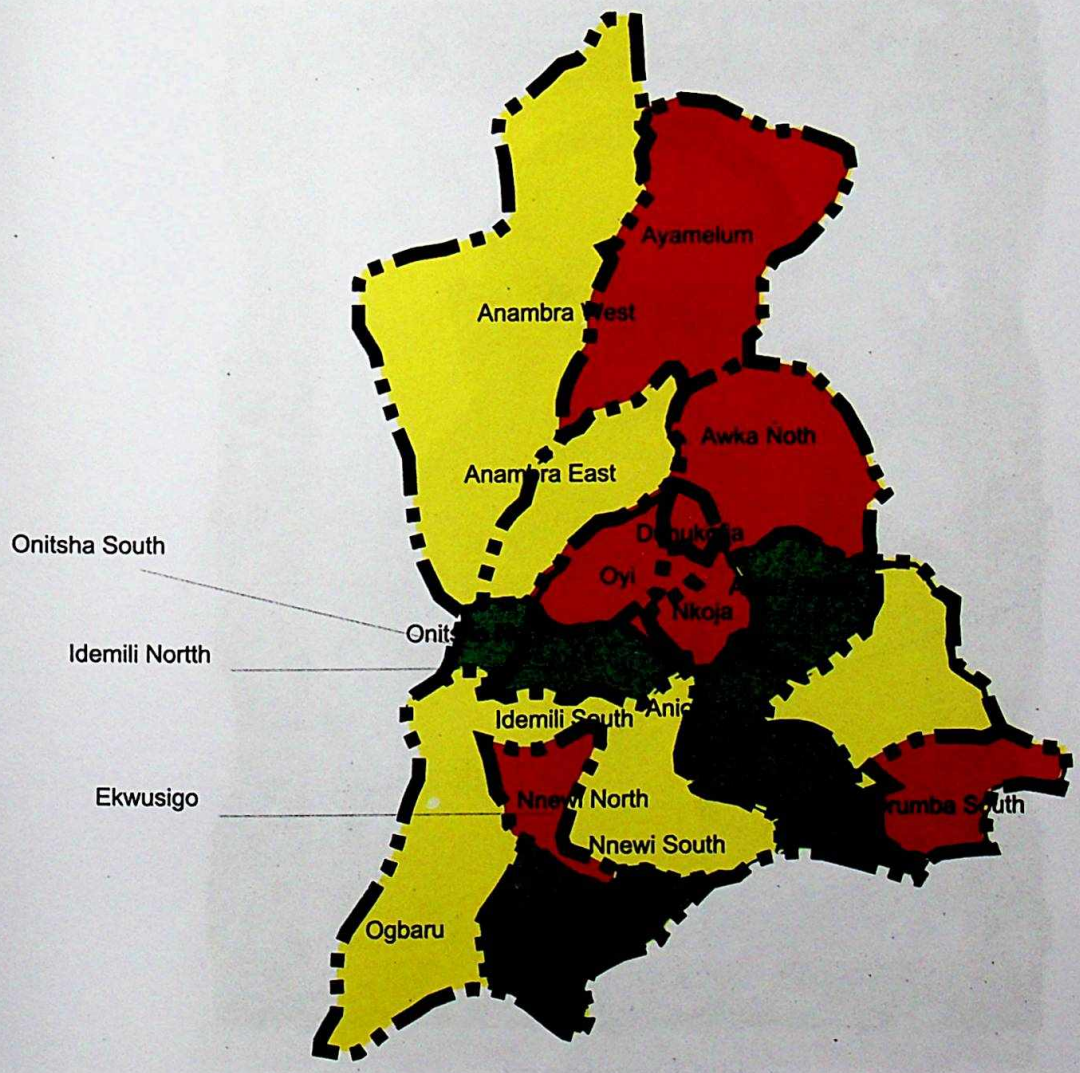

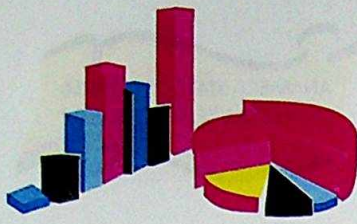

SHOWING THE 21 LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

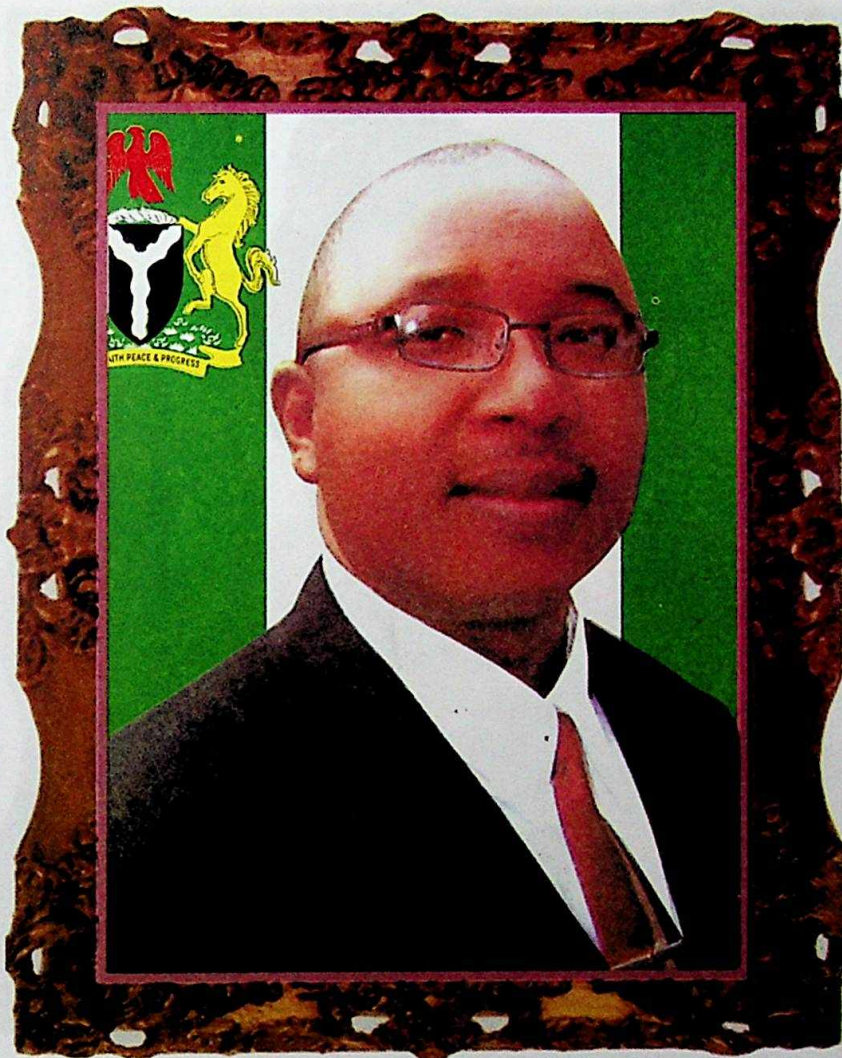
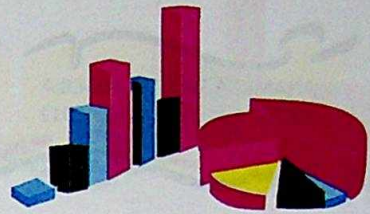




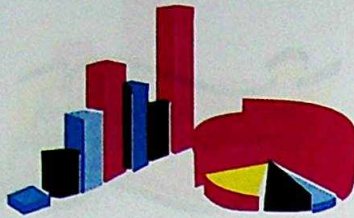
MAP OF ANAMBRA STATE
SHOWING THE 21 LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS



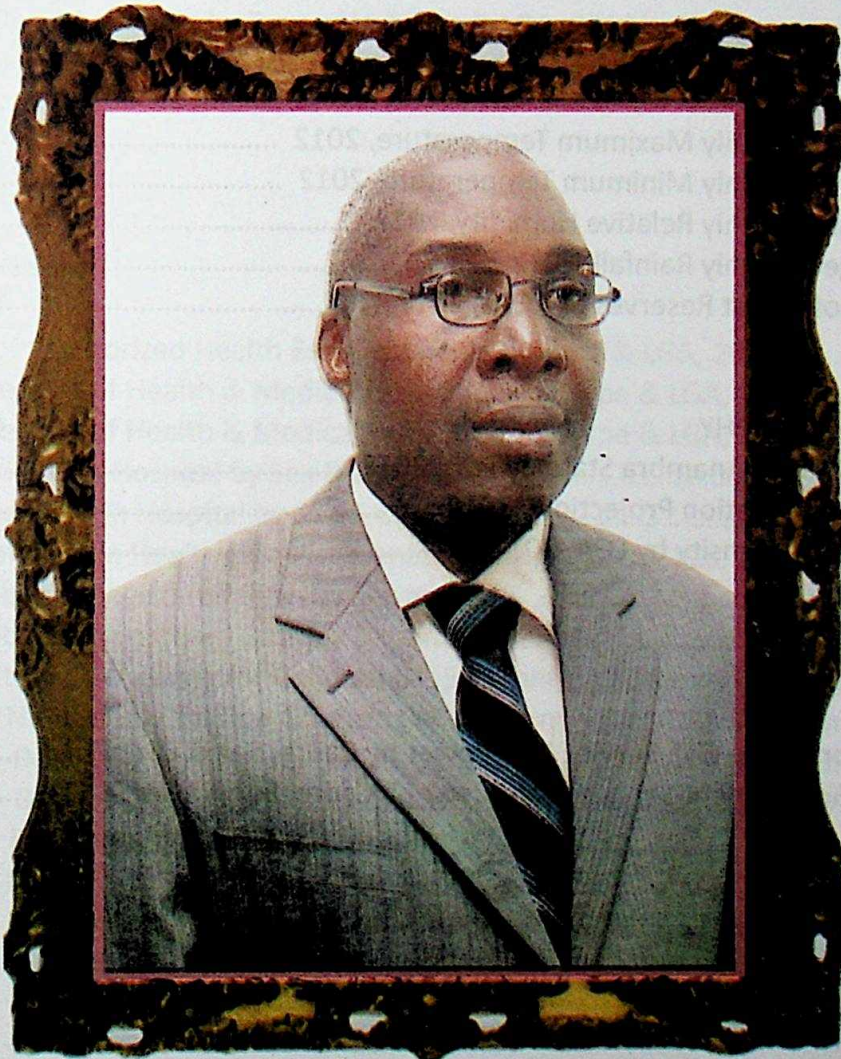

FOREWORD

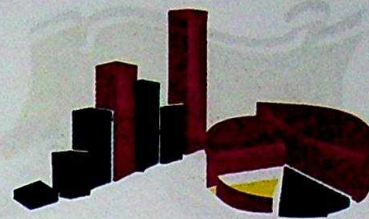

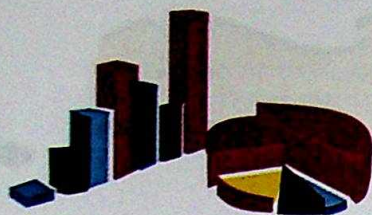

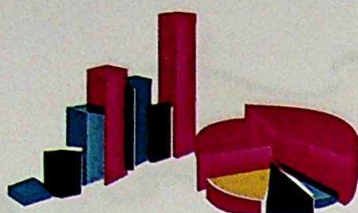
