## **SECTION 1**

### **MEDICAL AND HEALTH INSTITUTIONS**

Tables 1.1 and 1.2 show the Number of Registered Medical and Health Establishments in the State as classified by Local Government Areas.

Table 1.1 shows the total number of 1,560 Registered Health Institutions in the year 2008 and the number reduced by 10.64% (1,444) in the year 2009. Table 1.3 compares the number of Federal Government Health Institutions that are located in the state. From the table, in 2008 there were 13 Federal Government owned Medical and Health Institutions and the figure dropped to 11 in 2009.

Tables 1.4 and 1.5 show that Ibadan South West had the highest number of Medical and Health Institutions owned by the State Government. Five (5) Local Government Areas do not have State owned Medical and Health Institutions. General Hospital Constitute the largest state owned Medical and Health Institutions.

Table 1.6 and 1.7 reflects the distribution of Health Institutions owned by Local Governments in the State during the year 2008 and 2009. Table 1.7 shows an Increase in the number of Medical and Health Institutions by 48 in 2009 as compared to 608 Health establishments in 2008. Primary Health Centre Constitute the major Health Institution owned by the Local Government. Comprehensive Health Centre are not popular in the State.

Tables 1.8 and 1.9 Show Registered Private Medical and Health Institutions. In 2008, there were 885 registered Medical and Health Institutions spread all over the state. The number dropped by 163 in 2009. The highest number of 158 Medical and Health Institutions concentrated in Ibadan North Local Government while Ibarapa North had the least one registered private Medical and Health Institutions While the least figure was recorded for Atisbo Local Government. Private Maternity/Laboratories constituted the largest Medical and Health Institutions In 2008. while the Hospitals had the largest number in 2009 (330).

## **SECTION 2**

### **HEALTH PERSONNEL IN OYO STATE**

This section provides information on health personnel.

Table 2.1 and 2.2 provide data on health personnel in the State Public Health Institutions classified by Local Government area. In the year 2008 and 2009, Ibadan North had the highest number of (4554) and 3846 staff respectively which gives 39.4% and 40.3% of the total personnel in the state followed by Ibadan South West with 831 and 935 staff indicating 7.2% and 9.8% in that order. Oluyole Local Government recorded the least figure of personnel, 23 staff (0.2%) in 2008 and Ogo-Oluwa Local Government also had the least figure of 39 staff (0.4%) in 2009.

Table 2.3 gives Information on the number of selected Health personnel classified by categories. From the table, it was observed that the number of selected Health workers increased to 9549 in 2009 from 8925 in 2008, a difference of 624 Health Workers.

Tables 2.4 is a comparative analysis of selected category of Health Staff in the State Government Health Institution during the years 2005 to 2009. From the table, it was observed that there were fluctuations in the number of Medical Doctors, Nurses/Midwives and Pharmacists during the period. For instance, the year 2006 witnessed the least record of staff, while the year 2008 recorded the highest number of staff across the board of selected category.

Table 2.5 gives Information on selected Health personnel in Private Institutions in the State classified by Local Government. Saki West Local Government had the highest number of staff (499) representing 13% of the total staff, followed by Ibadan North East with 487 staff or 12.7% Afijio, Ibadan South West, Ido, Iwajowa, Lagelu, Ogbomoso South, Oluyole, Ona-Ara Oorelope, Oriire and Surulere recorded Nil.

Table 2.6 Provides information on distribution of Doctors among Health Institutions in the State Medical Institutions classified by Local Government. According to the table it is observed that Ibadan North had the highest number 511 Doctors representing 49.9% of the total Doctors. Akinyele had 64 Doctors (6.2%) but Ona-Ara and Surulere Local Government recorded no figure at all.

## **SECTION 3**

### **NUMBER OF BEDS**

This section gives information on the Number of Beds in Federal, State, Local and Private Health Institutions operating in the State.

In Table 3.1 and 3.2, there were 2,830 Beds in all of which 1,370 Beds were allotted to Teaching Hospital, followed by General Hospital with 680 while Dental Centers had the least number of 10 Beds in 2008. In 2009, 1,712 beds were recorded out of which General Hospital had the highest number of 704 beds followed by State Hospital with 565 Beds. The least bed of four (4) was observed for Dental Centers.

Table 3.3 and 3.4 highlight the number of Beds in the Local Government owned Medical and Health Institutions. From the table, Primary Health Centre had the largest number of 2523 and 2239 beds recorded in the year 2008 and 2009 respectively.

Meanwhile, in 2008 and 2009 FSP and Comprehensive Health Centre were observed to have the least number of 11 and 92 beds respectively.

Table 3.5 shows the number of Beds in Private Institutions operating in the State. A total number of 3,160 Beds were recorded out of which Hospital shared the highest number of 2,248 Beds, followed by Health Clinic with 533 beds Maternity/Laboratory recorded the least number of 379 Beds.

## **SECTION 4**

### **BIRTHS IN THE STATE MEDICAL INSTITUTIONS**

This section gives details account of Antenatal, Births, Live Births and Still Births in the State Medical and Health Institutions

Table 4.1 depicts Information on Antenatal attendance in Medical and Health Institutions classified by Local Government Areas. A total number of 177, 652 and 340, 340 attendants were recorded in 2008 and 2009 respectively. According to the table it was observed that Ibadan North Local Government had the highest Antenatal attendants in 2008 and 2009 with 30,727 and 43,183 respectively. Ogbomoso South was observed to have the least number of 247 Antenatal attendants in 2008, while in 2009 Ogo Oluwa Local Government had the least number of 1,455 attendants.

Table 4.2 shows that a total number of 42,885 and 57,611 births were recorded in 2008 and 2009 respectively in the State Medical and Health Institutions. Ibadan North Local Government recorded the highest number of Births with 6,335, and 10,080 in 2008 and 2009 respectively. The least number of 95 Birth in 2008 was recorded in Ogbomoso South Local Government Area while in 2009 Iwajowa Local Government recorded the least Births with 257.

On the part of still births, however the highest number of 3,498 was observed in 2008 with 2007 recording the least number of 502 still births.

## **SECTION 5**

### **BIRTH CONTROL METHODS**

The section focuses on Birth control Methods adopted by the users as registered in the family planning clinics in the State Medical and Health Institutions in 2008 and 2009.

Table 5.1 and 5.2 show monthly distribution of Birth control users classified by Local Government Areas, it was observed from the table that in 2008 and 2009, Ibadan North Local Government Area had the highest number of user with 9,173 and 8,828 respectively, followed by Ogbomoso North with 2,560 and 6,156 users for 2008 and 2009 respectively. The least number of 35 users was recorded in Iwajowa Local Government in 2008, while Kajola Local Government was observed to have the least with 102 users in 2009. The monthly distribution shows that in 2008, the highest number of users (4,440) was recorded in June while the highest was observed for the month of September (5,695) in 2009. Meanwhile, in 2008, the least number was recorded in April while in 2009 the least registration occurred in the month of January with 3,101 users.

## **SECTION 6**

### **IMMUNIZATION**

Table 6.1 and 6.2 show the number of children vaccinated against diseases in 2008 and 2009. A total number of 1,605, 619 and 1,779, 608 children were vaccinated in 2008 and 2009 respectively. Out of the total number vaccinated, DPT vaccination was observed to be the highest with 617, 408 in 2008 and 586, 964 in 2009. This is followed by Oral polio vaccine with 439, 445 in 2008 and 582,641 in 2009. Children vaccinated against yellow fever recorded the least figure of 170 276 in 2008 while children vaccinated against measles had the least record of 194,149 in 2009. It was also observed that Ibadan North Local Government had the highest immunized Children, numbering 130,597 and 130,263 in 2008 and 2009 respectively. Followed by Egbeda local Government with 109,596 children in 2008 and Ibadan South West with 102,035 in 2009. The least figure was observed for Ogo-Oluwa Local Government Area with 16,632 in 2008 while Olorunsogo had the least number of 21,748 children immunized in 2009.

Table 6.3 shows comparative analysis of data on children immunization for the year 2005-2009. The analysis reveals that in the last five years under study. The highest number of vaccination was observed in 2009 (1,779,608) The least figure of 406,512 children was observed to have been vaccinated in 2007.

## **SECTION 7**

### **DISEASES AND TREATMENT**

Table 7.1 and 7.2 focused on Patient Treated and Deaths Recorded in the State Medical Institutions. The tables show that more patients were treated for Malaria, while Leprosy Patient recorded the least figure with 37 and 212 in 2008 and 2009 respectively. It was observed from the tables that more people died as a result of Malaria in 2008 and 2009.

Table 7.3 is a comparative table showing cases of Water Borne Diseases reported in the State Medical and Health Institutions. The table shows more treated cases of Typhoid Fevers and Dysentery in 2008 and 2009. From the table, it was observed that Guinea Worm and Poliomyelitis were not common diseases in 2007 and 2008 while the effect of Poliomyelitis was also marginally in Year 2009.

Table 7.4 gives a comparative analysis on cases of Air Borne Diseases reported in Medical Institutions between 2007 and 2009. Pneumonia topped the list among other treated cases during the period under study. In 2009, 7406 cases of Pneumonia were treated, followed by tuberculosis with 5,857 (31%) out of the total number of cases of Air-borne Diseases reported (18,782).
