His Excellency the Executive Governor of Bauchi State, Mallam Isa Yuguda, Matawallen Bauchi appreciated the enormity of these problems associated with youth restiveness and therefore unveiled a ''Marshal plan '' for Youth rehabilitation and Development by establishing an Agency for youth and Women Rehabilitation and Development (BACYWORD).

The Agency is saddled with the responsibility of mopping up the restive youth off the streets by engaging them productively in various empowerment programmes such as Educational placement for indigent students, Skills acquisition to make them employable and employers of labour as well as direct Economic empowerment.

Two years into this journey, we are proud to say that we have delivered dividends of democracy to youth and women in Bauchi State through our multifaceted programmes and ignited the spirit of entrepreneurship in them. Many who have passed through BACYWORD programmes are today very successful small entrepreneurs who for ever will remain grateful to this Administration for giving them a hope and a future.

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The political revolution that brought about the new Administration in Bauchi State as a result of the 2007 elections raised a fundamental question as to what to do with the large number of unemployed youth and Women. The massive support enjoyed by the Governor, Mallam Isa Yuguda and his party, The All Nigerians People Party (ANPP) created its own problem of high expectation from the people, particularly, the Youth.

Another characteristic of the 4.6 million people of Bauchi State is the high level of illiteracy and poverty occasioned by the lack of skills among Youth and Women. It is also worthy to note that societal degeneration, parental poverty and the loss of values had resulted in waywardness of Youth to the extent that parents and guardians lost control of their respective wards. Even before the elections, there was this Youth restiveness that manifested itself in Youth gangsterism commonly referred to as "SARA'SUKA"", which was the wanton use of lethal weapons in minor disagreements whether social or political.

It is in this context that the Bauchi State Government unveiled its "Marshal Plan" to tackle the social and security implication that Youth restiveness pose to the very fabric of the society by creating the Bauchi State Commission for Youth and Women Rehabilitation and Development (BACYWORD) with a mandate to implement immediate, medium and long term strategies to tackle the menace.

2.0 MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE

The Commission was created in July 2007 and is directly under the office of the Governor. It is structured in a way that it can be highly responsive, strategic and efficient in the discharge of its mandate. The Commission is headed by an Executive Chairman who reports directly to His Excellency and is supported by three Permanent Commissioners and five Directors. To discharge it's mandate efficiently, the Commission operates with five Directorates which are;

- 1. Communication and strategy
- 2. Education and Rehabilitation
- 3. Economic Empowerment
- 4. Resource Management
- 5. Monitoring and Evaluation

2.1 THE MANDATE OF THE COMMISSION

BAYWARD has five core areas of intervention as follows:

- **2.1.1 Social Intervention:-** The Registration, Profiling and Categorization of all unemployed youth and women of Bauchi State, with a view to creating a comprehensive data bank on youth and women. This we use to explore possible collaboration with Development partners.
- **2.1.2 Educational Intervention:**-This intervention is aimed at achieving the followig:
- a) Finding placement in tertiary institutions for Bauchi State indigenes with requisite qualifications.
- b) Providing extra-mural classes to enhance their admissibility into tertiary institutions.
- c) Mitigating the high drop out rate among youth and women in our Primary, Secondary and Tertiary institutions.
- d) Fashion out appropriate measures to tackle the high rate of illiteracy among youth and women in Bauchi State generally.
- 2.1.3 **ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT:** To develop appropriate programmes for youth and women empowerment through skills acquisition, resettlement of trainees in various vacations and entrepreneurship training preparatory to absorption into private and public enterprises.
- 2.1.4 <u>PUBLIC WORKS</u>: To implement programmes that would absorb large number of unemployed youth in both urban and rural areas such as in agro—allied enterprises, sanitation, aforestation and rural co-operative entrepreneurship.
