

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF PROJECT NARRATION  
EXECUTED THROUGH PARTNERSHIP WITH THE 9  
LGS IN 2009 AND 2010**

The present administration in its laudable efforts to restore North East Arid Zone Development Programme (NEAZDP) activities, has approved the release of N9Million, monthly i.e N1Million from each of the 9 Local Government Areas of NEAZDP operational area to partake in various priority projects.

That NEAZDP has been mandated to prepare plan of activities to this regard every year and submit monthly/quarterly progress reports to Ministry for Local Government and Chieftaincy Affairs for onward submission to His Excellency.

- In view of the aforementioned, the sum of N99million have been received in 2009 and N45million in 2010.
- In compliance with the stated mandate, a plan of action for the year 2009 as well as 6 Progress Reports have been submitted. This year 2010, a plan of action was equally prepared and the First Quarter Progress Report has been forwarded.
- Attached are summary of projects executed from the funds received so far.
- That all projects executed in the year 2009 have been commissioned by Executive Governor of Yobe State His Excellency Alh. Ibrahim Gaidam particularly Strategic Grain Bank, Animal Traction Credit Loan Package, 3 Hilux Vehicle and a host of other projects executed through 2009 budget funding to NEAZDP.
- This submission is imperative to acquaint the Peer Review Team from the Secretariat of the Nigeria Governors Forum with achievements attained by NEAZDP in complimenting government efforts.
