8.0	STRUCTURE OF THE SUMMIT		
8.1	The structure of the forum is expected to take the following format;  i. Commissioning of papers: Experts will be contacted to write a 5-6 page paper on selected topics. A total of 6 papers will be written and be ready by end of August/early September.  ii. Review of Commissioned papers: Papers will be reviewed by a core group.  iii. Distribution of papers: Commissioned papers will be distributed to 36 states and the FCT and sent to all HLF participants at least 2 weeks ahead of the HLF on MDGs and related Issues. This is to ensure participants are conversant with the papers and to elicit their rich contribution during discussion of the papers.
