3.1	The Deputy Senate President (DSP) made a Presentation to the Forum on the Draft Constitution Amendment Bill as harmonised and adopted by the Joint Committee of the National Assembly. He presented 21 provisions and informed the meeting that these clauses were ready for transmission to the States Houses of Assembly for passing. He enlisted the support of the Forum. Members thanked the DSP for the Presentation but regretted that their input was not sought prior to the adoption by the National Assembly. Never the less, they promised to give the bill the seriousness it deserved. The Forum then constituted a Committee to review the Bill as presented and come up with a harmonised position for consultation with the Conference of Speakers: i.
