Research Question: What are the priority investments needed to achieve state and federal policy objectives in Nigeria?

Expected Outputs (2022):

- **Training in building and data collection for Social Accounting Matrix (SAM) and state-level analysis**
- **State-level workshops (2) and blog**

Responding to Crises



Research Questions: (1) What to do at the time of a crisis to mitigate negative effects (ex-post, short-term analyses, <1 year); and (2) How are systems are set up to ensure the effective mitigation of negative effects (ex-ante)? (medium-term analyses, 2-5 years).

Expected Outputs (2022):

- **Tools: Microsimulation tool based on household survey; Political Economy Toolkit for crises policy design**
- **Papers/seminars: Global shocks; local climatic shocks; conflicts**
