A LAW TO MAKE PROVISIONS FOR THE FINANCING OF THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE YEAR ENDING THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, TWO THOUSAND AND TWENTY AND FOR PURPOSES CONNECTED THEREWITH



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) Date of Commencement

**ENACTED** by the House of Assembly of Benue State of Nigeria as follows;

- This law may be cited as the REVENUE LAW 2020 and shall be deemed to have come into force on 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2020.
- 2. [1] The Accountant-General may, when authorized by warrant under the hand of the Governor, source income for the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the State, during the year ending the 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2020, any sum not exceeding in the aggregate \$\frac{\text{
  - [2] The sum specified above shall be generated from the sources set forth in PARTS A and C of the SCHEDULE to this Law as Revenue for the State.

**Title and Commencement**

- [3] The sum specified in sub-section (1) above shall be appropriated for the services set forth in PART B of the SCHEDULE to this Law.
- 3. Not withstanding anything contained in any Law or Authority in force in the State, all revenue generated and collected by a Ministry, Department or Agency (MDA) otherwise known as Public Sector Entity (PSE) shall be paid into the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the State before expenditures are made therefrom.
