Introduction

The 17 Sustainable Development Goals have given a blueprint to re-engineer our world by identifying key tasks and activities that focus on the Economics, Financial and Environmental pillars of society.

Thanks to the UN Systems in the country, Nigeria has been able to report on some indicators for SDGs like SDG 3 (Health), SDG 4 (Education), SDG 5 (Water).

However, this data does not capture the entire 36 States, and is limited in scope. This leaves a gap in the reporting for 14+ SDGs and their indicators.





The Challenge

What you don't know, you can't measure What you can't measure, you can't improve

How can you report SDG performance in a way that is credible and reliable?

Currently, National interventions are not metricdriven as led by OSSAP-SDG.

SDG Reporting on Nigeria is supposed to be an aggregation of the sum of its parts, with input from the 36 States + FCT.





Solution Methodology

Our approach to building subnational data is to make the subnational responsible for its data, by mapping each goal with an MDA.


Then build capacity within the MDA to track the targets and indicators.

This will be done through sensitization and training workshops

- Collation of data over a period
- Validation of data
- Reporting of data*






