

BRIEF ON KADUNA STATE OF NIGERIA

INTRODUCTION:

aduna State is one of the 36 States of the Federal Republic of Nigeria. Kaduna town was the Capital of the former Northern Region (Comprising the present Nineteen Northern State). It retained the position until the creation of new State in 1967. it than became the Capital of the former North- Central State which was later changed to Kaduna State as a result of Creation of more state in 1975. The State comprised of Zaria and Katsina province was curved out to form the present Katsina State.

GEOGRAPHY

Kaduna State occupies a central position in the map of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, and a landmass of about 30, 118 square kilometers. The name Kaduna is derived from the Hausa word KADA, which means crocodile, and KAUNA is the Hausa plural word for crocodiles, which abound in the river. Beside this river, there are other rivers like: the Gurara river, the Kagon river, the Kubanni river and Bagoma river to mention a few. The life of the people of the state has been greatly influenced by their

geographical setting. The two climatic conditions in the state greatly influence activities of the people, who are predominately occupied in agriculture during rainy season which lasts for about six months from May to October, and occupied in cultural festivals and commercial activities during the dry season which lasts from Nov-April.

POPULATION

Kaduna State is one of the most densely populated states in Nigeria. This is as a result of the Liberal nature if the state that it accommodates all kinds of people. It has a population of more than 6 million according to the 2006 population Census. Some of the major ethnic groups in the state includes: Hausa, Fulani, Bajju, Ham, Atyap, Lkulu, Agrok, Atakad, Adara, Chawai, Ninzo and Numana.

ARTS AND CULTURE

The state has a rich cultural heritage in terms of festivals, music, dance, crafts and even administration. It has 32 autonomous traditional instructions in the form of Emirate Council mostly in the Northern part and Chiefdoms in the southern part.

Kaduna State people are highly religious. The major religions in the state are Islam and Christianity, with Islam predominantly practiced in the Northern part and Christianity in the Southern part. Traditional religion is still practiced in some areas within the state side by side with the two orthodox religions.

Kaduna State is internationally acclaimed for famous Nok Culture. Village is in Jaba Local Government of the State and is where the NOK terracotta head was discovered and dated as far back as 500 BC.

GOVERNMENT

The Kaduna State Government is made up of Executive, Legislature and the Judiciary. The principle of Separation of power is very much applicable here as in other state of the federation.

The Executive arm of the Government is made up of the Governor, his deputy, and members of the state Executive council. This arm of the Government is responsible for policy formula and programme implementation.

The Kaduna State House of Assembly is made up of the Honourable Speaker, his deputy and the representatives of the various state constituencies on a single vote basis. There are 27 Legislators in all, representing the 23 Local Government councils in the state.

GEO-POLITICAL SET UP

Kaduna State has 23 Local Government Council divided into three geo-political zones.

TOURISM

The tourism potentials of Kaduna State are enormous. All the geo-political zones of the state have impressive tourist attractions whose economic viability are yet to be fully tapped.

The tourism endowments of Kaduna state include: The Nok terracotta sites, Nok Museum,

Matsirga Waterfall, the Kagoro Hills, the Kamuku National Park, the queen Amina city walls and the Tomb of Bakwa Turunku. Others include:- the General Hassan Usman Katsina Park, the Lord Lugard Hall, Arewa House, National Museum Kaduna to mention but a few.

ECONOMY

With a vibrant, highly educated and highly industrious manpower, Kaduna State is a fertile ground for investment, especially in agriculture and agro allied venture. Kaduna state is blessed with abundant mineral resources such as molbite Aquamarine sapphires, and gold. Cash crops grown in the state include cotton, groundnut, tobacco, sugar cane, ginger, chilies, sheanut and soyabean. Animals reared in the state include cattle, sheep, Goats, and poultry production.

HOSPITALITY

Kaduna State people are known and recognized for their hospitality, that is why it is described as the melting pot of Nigeria. This is more pronounced under the dynamic leadership of His Excellency, Alhaji Ahmed Mohammed Makarfi, the Executive Governor of Kaduna State. This has enhanced the economy growth of Kaduna State in no small way. Welcome to Kaduna State, the center of learning.

MAJOR FESTIVALS IN KADUNA STATE

1. KADUNA STATE FESTIVAL OF ARTS AND CULTURE

This is an annual festival organized by Kaduna State Ministry of culture and tourism. It is a forum where all the 23 Local government areas in the state, and private cultural organizations, show case their culture, expose talent, and through these, promote Unity and encourage tourism in the state. It takes place in November/December of every year.

2. EID EL FITR AND EID-EL-ADHA CELEBRATIONS

This is scheduled on the 1st of shawwal and the 10th of Dhul-Hajj respectively according to Islamic Calendar for 3 days. Usually Muslim all over the world celebrate the end of the Ramadan fasting period and the conclusion of the Hajj (Pilgrimage) rites. Most of the Emirates in Kaduna State and other parts of the northern part of the country celebrate it with a colourful Mini Durbar.

3. CHRISTMAS CELEBRATIONS This take place every December 25th/26th to celebrate the birth of Jesus by Christians all over the world.

4. EASTER CELEBRATIONS It takes place April/may of every year to commemorate the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ by all Christians.

Tuk-HAM FESTIVAL This was originally a thanksgiving festival for ham people which lasts for 2 days. It is now a forum where all sons and daughters of Ham come together annually, for colourful display of the rich culture of the people in Jaba Local Government Area.

6. AFAN CULTURAL FESTIVAL This is celebrated every 1st of January at Fadan Kagoro. It has assumed an international standard with the sons and daughters of Aegworok land coming together to discuss issues that need their attending and to display their rich cultural heritage.

7. KALANKUWA CULTURAL FESTIVAL This is purely a cultural festival that is celebrated in the Northern part of the state. It is a kind of thanksgiving festival celebrated after the harvest season

(Nov. /Dec). It entails young men and women coming together, in a peaceful and friendly atmosphere, to entertain themselves. It is celebrated in Borno Village, Samaru, in Sabon Gari Local Government Area of the state.

8. OTHER CULTURAL FESTIVALS

Other similar festivals but less pronounced are the Tuk-Gwong, the Baranzan (Bajju), the Bakulu (Ikulu), the Anghan (Kamantan), the Adara (Kadara), the Aninkon (Kaninko) the Moroa, the Ninzo, the Kataf and the Attakad. Most of them take place at the beginning of the year in January with a few at the end of the year and in April/May.


ADMINISTRATIVE MAP OF NIGERIA




ADMINISTRATIVE MAP OF KADUNA STATE




STATE HEADQUARTER TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT KILOMETER CHART







MAP OF CHUKUN LOCAL GOVERNMENT





MAP OF KAJURU LOCAL GOVERNMENT







MAP OF KAURU LOCAL GOVERNMENT





MAP OF KUDAN LOCAL GOVERNMENT

MAP OF LERE LOCAL GOVERNMENT






MAP OF SOBA LOCAL GOVERNMENT




