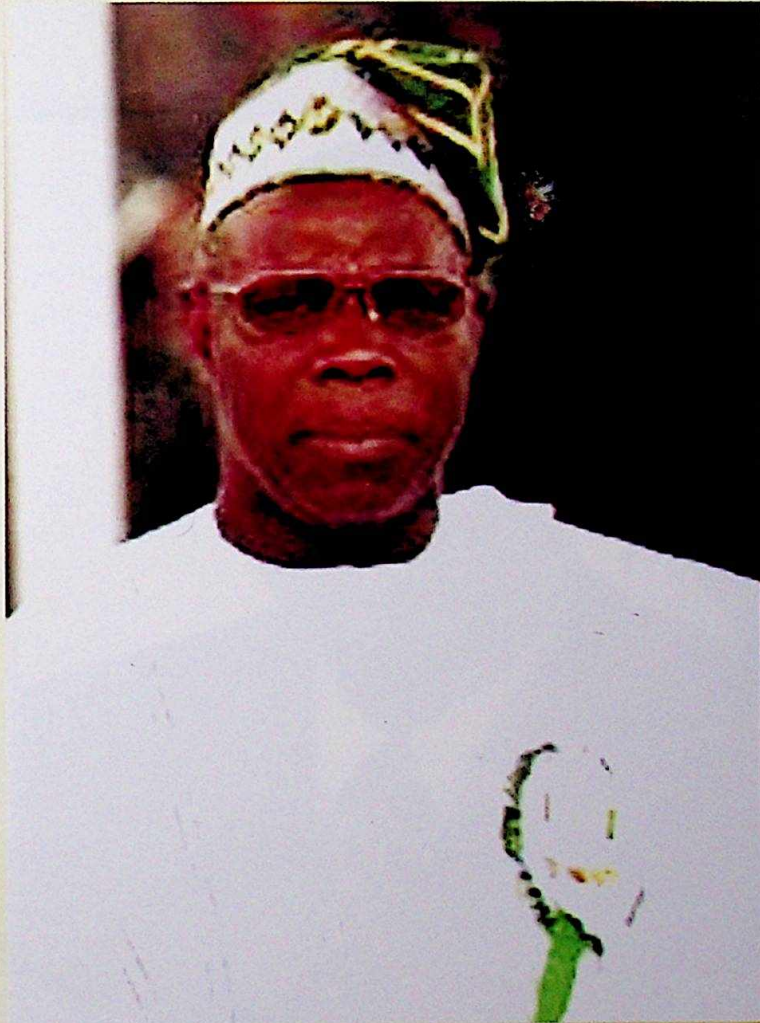

The purpose of this briefing is to intimate you, gentlemen of the media, with the operational framework of this Commission; as well as seek your co-operation, encouragement and support, as we go along the many curves, en route our daunting but achievable task of delivering a truly next-level National Sports Festival organizing and hosting.

Members of the Commission are quite mindful of the mandate given to this body by Otunba Gbenga Daniel, the Governor of the State and we are determined to ensure that this administration's resolve to change the face of the National Sports Festival becomes a reality.



That had been aptly demonstrated by the State from the zero hour, when the bid document was submitted at the office of the Honourable Minister of Sports and Social Development in Abuja in 2004.

Months before the June 18, 2004 announcement of the bid winner, Otunba Gbenga Daniel set in motion the machinery towards providing State of the Art facilities for the 15th National Sports Festival christened, **Gateway Games 2006**.

That sheer doggedness has today metamorphosed into the upgrading and provision of several social and physical amenities, bound to distinctly raise the profile of the Festival and which, after the event, will be converted into commercial purposes by the Government.

These include a modern **Games Village in Ijebu-Ode** for the use of Ogun State Athletes tagged **Team Ogun**.

Others are the **OGD Low-Cost Housing Estate at Asero in Abeokuta**; the renovation of the **Muda Lawal Stadium, Abeokuta; Ilaro Stadium; Ijebu-Ode Stadium**; and the imposing **M.K.O. Abiola Stadium**.

To further add value to this hosting challenge, the Otunba Gbenga Daniel-led administration has entered into an agreement with a private firm, **LILBURN Millennia Projects Nigeria Ltd**, for the construction of **2007 Housing Units** at a location on the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway. The housing units are to accommodate athletes and officials of participating States and the F.C.T. during the Festival.

As if that was not enough, the foundation of the **Media Village, the first in the 35-year history of the competition**, was laid by Otunba Daniel a couple of weeks ago. The uniqueness of this venture is a further emphasis of the private-sector driven approach to the overall organization and management of the **Gateway Games 2006**.

PRIVATE SECTOR INVOLVEMENT

By far, the most significant responsibility of the Commission is to generate funds and material resources for the successful packaging and execution of the games.

This we have taken with a great sense of responsibility. In this light, we have commenced efforts at contacting leading sports-friendly corporate institutions in various parts of the federation.

I am pleased to state here that so far, the responses have not only been overwhelming; but reassuring and encouraging. This makes us quite optimistic that we shall not only make a success of the Games; but also excel in our task of having a through and through private-sector driven National Sports festival.

GATEWAY GAMES 2006 PATRONS

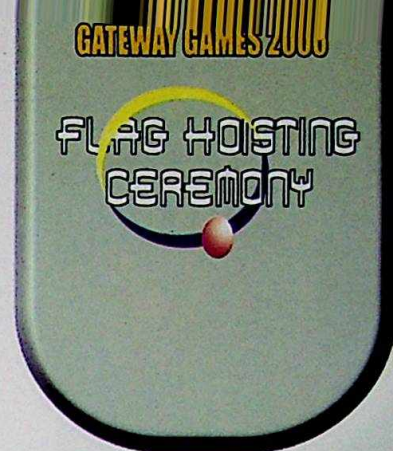
To demonstrate our seriousness, the decoration of our **Patrons and Patronesses** whom we believe would support Gateway Games 2006 morally and financially have commenced.

LEAD-UP ACTIVITIES

The Commission has lined-up several lead-up activities aimed at sensitizing Nigerians on the Gateway Games 2006 as well as generating the much desired private sector resources.

The first is the **Flag Hoisting Ceremony** billed to hold at the M.K.O. Abiola Stadium, Kuto, Abeokuta on Wednesday 6th of April, 2006.

Undoubtedly a novelty in the annals of National Sports Festival organizing in the nation since 1973, the Flag Hoisting event is a special celebration evening of the age-long ideals of the festival; which is to promote national unity, understanding, friendliness and brotherly love.

It is an event where all participating State's shall deliver their colours formally, before a Nationwide Television Audience; amidst fun-fare and public pledges towards ensuring the presentation of well-trained, healthy, physically fit and disciplined contingents; all to the glory of the 15th National Sports Festival tagged Gateway Games 2006.

Among other things, this programme is one of the Commission's platforms of inculcating the spirit of peaceful co-existence, healthy rivalry and competitive spirits in Nigeria's Athletes, from their very young ages.

All Commissioners of Sports and Directors of Sports in Nigeria have signified their readiness to be part of the epoch making event. As I speak 31 States of the Federation have sent in their flags for the event.

The Honourable Minister of Sports and Social Development, Col. Musa Mohammed (rtd), and Minister in The Presidency/Chairman, Federal Capital Development Authority (FCDA), Mallam Nasir El-Rufai, are the Guests of Honour while the Ogun State Governor, Otunba Gbenga Daniel is the Chief Host.

Notable Nigerians who have contributed immensely to sports development in different capacities have equally been invited to the event.

GATEWAY 2006 THEME SONG COMPETITION:

On behalf of His Excellency, Governor Gbenga Daniel, Chairman, Gateway Games 2006 Commission, I want to express appreciation to all Nigerian groups, individuals and organizations that have sent in demos or made presentations on a theme song for the Sports Festival.

I however have the mandate of the Commission to announce that the theme song for the festival will be chosen via a 3-month screening exercise to be conducted by Gateway Radio between May and July this year.

All interested groups and organizations are hereby advised to forward their entries in triplicate, complete with lyrics and clean studio-produced CDs, to the General Manager, Gateway Radio, who has been mandated to coordinate that exercise. Further details in this regard can be obtained from his office.

All collected entries will be played generously for a period of one month from August 1-30 and the best entry selected by a voting plan that will be transparently managed by the Management of Gateway Radio.

Several other lead-up activities are also coming on stream between now and early next year. These include:

- v Gateway Games 2006 Peace Torch. Movement to all the States of the Federation shall start from the Federal Capital Territory in June 2005.
- v Gateway Games 2006 Beauty Pageant. Winner shall emerge on the 28th May, 2005.
- v Executive Dash, etc. etc.

We shall be briefing you accordingly ahead of these various programmes.
