MVP Ikaram

- ▶ The MVP concept is a collaborative initiative of Ondo State in partnership with the Earth Institute, New York, Millennium Promise and the UNDP.
- ▶ The main objective is to practicalise the attainment of MDGs in selected communities notably Erusu, Ibaram, Iyani, Ikaram, Ase, Gedegede and Ajowa (22,000 pop.)
- ▶ Nigeria have two (2) Millennium Villages at Ikaram-Ibaram and Pampaida, Kaduna State.

Key Achievements- Agriculture

- ▶ Distribution of Agricultural inputs e.g Fertilizers, Agro chemicals, certified and improved seeds & crop seedlings to farmers.
- ▶ Construction of 800 tonnes cereal bags for storage of agricultural produce.
- ▶ Procurement of 3 sheller machines to farmers groups to add value to harvested maize produce
- ▶ Training and retraining of farmers on crop and livestock production to update farmers' knowledge on modern farming practices.

Key Achievements - Education

- ▶ Construction of 54 Classrooms and renovation of 35 Classrooms.
- ▶ Annual distribution of Textbooks, teaching aids, and science kits to schools.
- ▶ Training of 209 teachers on classroom methodologies and improved teaching techniques.
- ▶ Establishment of 2 functional Adult Literacy centres
- ▶ Construction of 16 resource rooms equipped with computer
- ▶ Supply of 1,200 desks and benches to primary schools.

Key Achievements- Gender & Women Empowerment

- ▶ Gender mainstreaming across all project interventions.
- ▶ Capacity building and financial empowerment for 100 Women on Tye and Dye production.
- ▶ Peer education programme on Sexual and Reproductive Health in schools and communities.
- ▶ Production and distribution of gender sensitive IEC materials across project sectors
- ▶ Facilitation of vocational training linkages for women and vulnerable groups.

Key Achievements -Health

- ▶ Distribution of over 20,000 Insecticide Treated Bednets
- ▶ Provision of Free Health Care Services
- ▶ Recruitment of 24 Voluntary Village Health Workers
- ▶ Renovation of 3 Health Centres and facilitation of national grid
- ▶ Procurement and distribution of drugs and equipment
- ▶ Provision of home based care and regular home visits to pregnant women.
- ▶ Introduction of Deworming programmes at schools and communities.

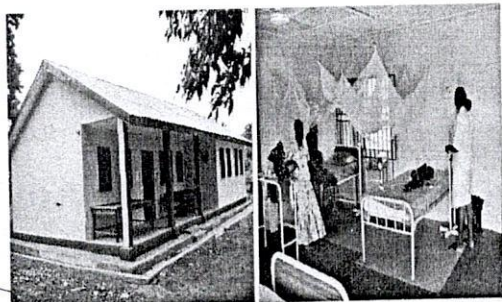
Key Achievements - Water & Sanitation

- › Construction of 5 Solar-powered boreholes within the cluster.
- › Construction of 14 handpump-fitted boreholes in primary schools
- › Construction of 28 units of six compartments Gender separated VIP toilets.
- › Procurement and distribution of sanitation distribution materials i.e wheelbarrows, rake,shovels and reflective jackets to 16 primary schools and 7 cluster villages

Key Achievements - ICT

- › Establishment of functional ICT and Youth-friendly centres at Erusu, Ibaram, Ikaram and Ajowa.
- › Installation of 3G Internet Connectivity in the cluster through partnership with MTN and Ericsson International.
- › Procurement and distribution of 3 Desktop computers each in 16 primary schools in the cluster to boost ICT education.

Introduction

- ▶ Conditional Grant Scheme otherwise known as CGS is one of the means of fasttracking the achievement of MDGs in Nigeria.
- ▶ Under the CGS, Nigeria is committed to spending its debt relief gains on pro- poor projects and programmes in support of national effort to achieve MDGs.
- ▶ Ondo State began implementation of the CGS scheme in 2007
- ▶ The CGS has been scaled up to 4 pilot Local Government Areas in Ondo State namely Ile Oluji/ Oke-Igbo, Ondo East, Akoko North East and Akoko West.

INTRODUCTION

- State application for CGS focused on Goals where the State have critical development challenges such as
 - Health
 - Water, and
 - Eradication of extreme poverty.
- Project selection based on participatory approach: Due consultation with MDAs, LGAs and Benefiting Communities
- Project monitoring Team in place: MDAs PSU and Local Project Monitoring Committee.

CHALLENGES

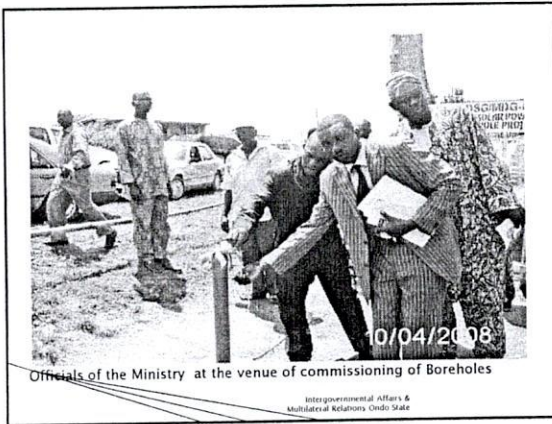
- LATE RENDERING OF RETURNS FROM MDAS

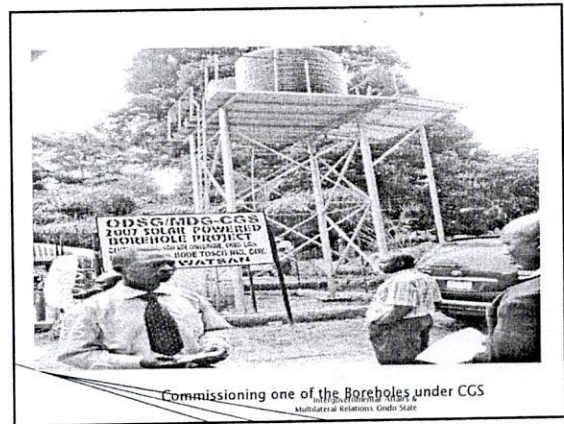

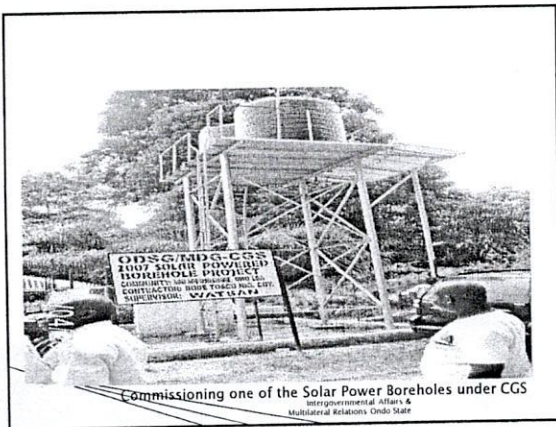
