

# HEALTH UPDATE

FEBRUARY 26<sup>TH</sup>, 2020

### Highlights

- Seattle Commitments Honourable Commissioners of Health onboarded; BMGF to launch a leadership challenge.
- Disease Outbreaks Lassa fever in 26 states and the FCT, 103 deaths recorded so far.
- Basic Healthcare Provision Funds Update Disbursement discontinued until operational guidelines is reviewed.
- State Social Health Insurance Scheme 34 states have created their Health Insurance Agencies; Akwa Ibom and Rivers outstanding.
- Follow up to Last Call to Action Akwa Ibom and Rivers state Governors to facilitate the establishment of their SHIA.

### 1. Seattle Commitments

- Honourable Commissioners of Health met on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> of February to operationalize commitments.
- Thirty-three states were represented; Osun, Enugu and Benue were absent with apologies.
- Draft indicators for tracking progress on Seattle Commitments developed.
- Reporting on Commitments to the NGF to commence in March, 2020.
- BMGF to launch a Leadership Challenge similar to the immunization leadership challenge.
- 2. RI/PHC MOU between state governors, BMGF, Aliko Dangote Foundation (ADF) and other partners.
  - There is an MOU on RI/PHC between Bauchi, Borno, Kaduna, Kano, Sokoto and Yobe States and BMGF, ADF and other partners.
  - This MOU was reviewed via a virtual telephone call between the state governors of the respective states, Federal Ministry of Health and partners.

### 3. Basic Healthcare Provision Fund.

- First tranche of funds has been released to twenty-two states on either the NHIS or NPHCDA gateways of the BHCPF, but many states are unable to access the funds. (See attachment)
- Disbursements have been stalled due to the ongoing review of BHCPF operational guidelines.
- Representatives of the Honourable Commissioners of Health are part of the review process.


### 4. State Social Health Insurance Scheme.

- Significant progress made on SSHIS implementation.
- Thirty-four states have established their State Health Insurance Agencies.
- Ekiti state has commenced enrolment into the SSHIS, bringing total number of states that have commenced enrolment to 17 states.

#### **CALL TO ACTION FOR GOVERNORS**


- Akwa Ibom and Rivers State Governors to expedite action to ensure successful take-off of SSHIS.
- Governors to sustain commitment to improving PHC performance.

### i. Lassa Fever

- Currently in 26 states and the FCT.
- Worst hit states are Edo (35%), Ondo (32%) and Ebonyi (6%). (See map).
- So far, 103 deaths have been recorded.
- There are 2176 suspected cases since the beginning of the year.
- Edo and Ondo states could share experiences.

### ii. Coronavirus

- WHO has declared COVID-19 a global pandemic.
- No reported case in Nigeria.
- Four new countries (Afghanistan, Bahrain, Iraq and Oman) reported cases of COVID-19
- Thirty-four countries have confirmed cases of COVI-19
- Globally, there are 80,239 confirmed cases.
- NCDC with Africa Disease Control organized a capacity strengthening programme for preparedness against Coronavirus
