LAW NO. 1 (2022)

A Law to appropriate out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the services of the Government of Cross River State of Nigeria for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 2022, the sum of One Hundred and Eighteen Billion, Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six Million, Three Hundred and Fifty-Four Thousand, One Hundred and Seven Naira, Ninety-Six Kobo aforesaid, to authorize out of the Capital Development Fund, the sum of Two Hundred and Twenty-Five Billion, Seven Hundred and Forty-Six Million, Two Hundred and Sixty-One Thousand, Six Hundred and Four Naira, Ninety-Eight Kobo.


Commencement.

The Cross River State House of Assembly enacts as follows –

Enactment.


1. The Accountant-General of Cross River State of Nigeria may, when authorized so to do by Warrants issued by the Governor, pay out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the State during the year ending on the 31st day of December, 2022 the sums specified by the Warrants, not exceeding in the aggregate One Hundred and Eighteen Billion, Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six Million, Three Hundred and Fifty-Four Thousand, One Hundred and Seven Naira, Ninety-Six Kobo being the total of the amount set out opposite the Heads of Expenditure in Schedule 1 and may for the like period and in like manner pay out of the Capital Development Fund the sums specified by Warrants not exceeding in the aggregate Two Hundred and Twenty-Five Billion, Seven Hundred and Forty-Six Million, Two Hundred and Sixty-One Thousand, Six Hundred and Four Naira, Ninety-Eight Kobo being the total of the amounts set out opposite the Heads of Expenditure in Schedule 2.
Issue of N118,956,354,107.96 and N225,746,261,604.98 out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and Capital Development Fund respectively.
2. The said sums, not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of Three Hundred and Forty-Four Billion, Seven Hundred and Two Million, Six Hundred and Fifteen Thousand, Seven Hundred and Twelve Naira, Ninety-Four Kobo shall be appropriated for the purpose and in the manner expressed in the relevant Schedules.
Appropriation of N118,956,354,107.96 (Schedule 1) and N225,746,261,604.98 (Schedule 2).
3. The said sum does not include Statutory Votes of Nine Billion, Eight Hundred and Two Million, Nine Hundred and Nineteen Thousand, Six Hundred Naira, Thirty-One Kobo being the Votes so extracted from the Heads of Expenditure set out in Schedule 3 hereto.
Statutory Votes of N9,802,919,600.31 (Schedule 3).
4. No part of the amount mentioned in Section 2 of this Law shall be issued out of the respective funds after the 31st day of December, 2022.
Prohibition of issue after 31st December, 2022.
5. (1) The power to issue Warrants for the purpose of this Law shall be deemed to have been delegated by the State Governor to the Commissioner for Finance.
Delegation of Issue of Warrants
(2) Notwithstanding the delegation of power under sub-section (1) of this Section, the State Governor may himself exercise the power to issue Warrants under this Law.
6. This Law may be cited as the Cross River State Appropriation Law 2022, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 2022.
